Madison County Fair Association Ambassador Application

The Madison County Fair Ambassador program is open to all MCFA exhibitors who meet the requirements listed below.

1. The student must enter a project in the fair during the year of ambassador service.
2. The student must be a sophomore, junior, or senior (or home school equivalent) during the year of service. Students who have served may reapply but are not automatically guaranteed acceptance. Maximum years of service is three.
3. Selection will be based on this written application and an interview.
4. The deadline for submitting applications is May 1st. Applications may be mailed or submitted to fair personnel. Club leader / advisor contact information must be provided on the applications. Listed advisors will be contacted as references.
5. Interviews will be conducted during May or early June. A panel of adult advisors will review and select the appropriate individuals. You will be notified in June if you have been accepted as a Madison County Fair Ambassador. Submitting an application or participating in an interview does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
6. All ambassadors are required to submit the ambassador follow-up report (available on mcfa.net) by May 1st at the conclusion of their year of service. Failure to submit a follow-up report will be considered non-completion of ambassador duties.
7. Final reports will be reviewed by the executive committee of the fair board. Scholarships will only be awarded to applicants who have successfully completed all duties and properly documented his / her year of service.
