a. Division Assurance Survey Results and Discussion

14 parents responded

For Faith parents were happy with teachers sharing their faith but a lot responded 'I don't know' for participating in school liturgies which is like a negative. For students 60 students responded, students said faith helps them but students are also responding with lower response scores for participating in school liturgies.

For Data we did well with engaging and challenging work, but will focus on a variety of methods for learning. Students say that they did do a good job but responded they would like more feedback. Parents noted that teachers are there to help them but not if they are related to school work. Parents are happy that students are learning how to use technology safely, and would like to focus on a more welcoming environment and were not too sure if students follow the rules. Students were happy that students treat each other with respect, but want a focus on belonging and following rules. Parents are happy that this is a good school, but have a focus on building a positive reputation in the community (some responded I don't know) Students know how to access information and students are also responding that school does not have a positive reputation.

- b. <u>Safe and Caring School Policy</u> approval -went through the Student handbook -Safe and Caring Policy. Yvonne said it looked good. No other responses.
 - 9. Teacher Representative Tracy Delhez- talked about a survey that went out to discuss mental health needs, our responses matched SACHS (Anxiety and Organization). We have a group that meets with PhD student (that is currently working with Tracy) and have been helping students with test anxiety and ongoing organizational supports. We also work with students with other supports like job applications, resumes, career and class choice discussions, applying for funding, taxes, and grants (adult students), and educational testing.
