They outlined their Memory Park Volunteering program, AMAZING website, their Environment Club and website which helps to facilitate citizen science projects. They outlined their National Tree Day and Clean Up Australia Day activities, work on solar panels, upcycled benches, timber recycling, bicycle racks and hydroponic garden. We watched a video explaining their relationship with UNSW and the technology they have used to upcycle textiles and remanufacture them into benchtops - GREEN CERAMICS.
