

Nov. 4, 2025 Operating Levy to Sustain Student Programs and Services

What's on the Ballot?

The Perrysburg Board of Education has placed a **7.83-mill emergency operating levy** on the Tuesday, **November 4, 2025** ballot. If approved, the **five-year** levy would generate approximately **\$11 million annually** to **sustain student programs and services**.

How Much will it Cost?

For every **\$100,000 of appraised home value**, the levy would cost **\$274 a year**. Because the Perrysburg High School bond is ending this year, the **net impact would be \$214.55 a year** (about \$17.88 a month)—**\$126.70 less than the levy proposal rejected last year**. Because it is fixed-sum, the total collected **would not increase over time**; as homes and businesses are added to the community, the cost per property owner would decrease.

Efficiency Measures and Budget Actions in Place

Perrysburg Schools continues to implement **efficiency measures** and has already made **\$6 million in cuts**. These cuts are already impacting students in the current school year through larger class sizes, fewer academic options, reduced extracurricular offerings, and scaled-back support services.

Looking Ahead to 2026–2027

Without new funding provided by the proposed levy, additional reductions will be required, affecting **student learning environments, opportunities and enrichment in academics, arts and athletics, as well as access to individual support**.

Impact on Students if the Levy is Rejected
