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Senior Portrait Submission

Deadline: Friday, December 20, 2025

Steps to Submit:

1. Name your photo file using the student's legal first and last name.
2. Complete the [Senior Photo Submission Form](#), including your senior's quote (optional) and preferred name. Attach the photo in the designated section.
3. Submit the form. You will receive a confirmation list in early February.

Portrait & Quote Guidelines

- Submit **high-resolution JPG photos** with a 2:3 aspect ratio.
- Portraits should be appropriate and follow Cleveland's dress code: no hats, caps, masks, hand signals, face paint, slogans, or photo distortions.
- Quotes (optional) may be up to **25 words**.
- The Legend reserves the right to refuse inappropriate portraits or quotes.
- Seniors will have a chance to confirm their portraits in February through school communications.

Please submit photos only via the form to avoid lost files.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

When is the Ordering Deadline?

We order a limited number of yearbooks, which usually sell out. Order early to guarantee your copy!

When and How is Distribution?

- Yearbooks are distributed in late May or early June.
- A valid ID is required to pick up a yearbook.
- You may not pick up a yearbook for a friend but may pick one up for a sibling.

What Happens to Unclaimed Yearbooks?

Yearbooks unclaimed by **December** (about 7 months after distribution) will be made available to the public. Please collect your yearbook promptly!
