




Allen, Josh. *Out to get you: 13 tales of weirdness and woe*. New York, Holiday House, 2019.


Summary: A collection of thirteen short stories that reveals frightening secrets lurking in everyday objects.

Anderson, M. T. *Thirsty*. Cambridge, Mass, Candlewick Press, 1997.


Summary: From the moment he knows that he is destined to be a vampire, Chris thirsts for the blood of people around him while also struggling to remain human.


Neverland, the madness of Wonderland, and beyond. Can twins Alex and Conner catch up to the Masked Man?"

Colfer, Chris. *The Enchantress returns*. New York Boston, Little, Brown and Company, 2013.



Colfer, Chris. *A Grimm Warning*. New York, Little, Brown And Co, 2015.



Ellis, Deborah. *No ordinary day*. Toronto, Groundwood Books, 2011.





Hitchcock, Shannon. *One true way*. New York, Scholastic Press, 2018.



Kinney, Jeff. *Diary of a wimpy kid: wrecking ball*. New York, Amulet Books, 2020.


Summary. An unexpected inheritance allows the Heffley family to make major improvements to their home, but construction causes so much trouble they consider just moving, instead.

Levithan, David. *Someday*. New York, Alfred A. Knopf, 2018.


Summary. When A discovers there are others who wake up in a different person's body every day, A gains new understanding of the extremes where love and loneliness can lead. Told from multiple perspectives.

Lupica, Mike. *Last man out*. New York, Philomel Books, 2016.




Summary. Discover the truth about the world's most fascinating and magical creatures that have been featured in legends and tales for centuries.




FIC MEY

Mull, Brandon. *Time Jumpers*. New York, Aladdin, 2018.



Patterson, James. *The dangerous days of Daniel X*. New York, Little, Brown, 2008.



Patterson, James. *Laugh out loud*. New York Boston, Little, Brown and Company, 2017.


Summary: Imaginative middle schooler Jimmy follows his dream to start a unique book company while he is still a child.

Reynolds, Jason. *Miles Morales, Spider-Man*. Los Angeles New York, Marvel Press, 2017.



Rice, Luanne. *Pretend she's here*. New York, NY, Scholastic Press, 2019.



Philbrick, W. R. *Wildfire: a novel*. New York, Blue Sky Press, an imprint of Scholastic Inc, 2019.






FIC SHE

Sheinmel, Alyssa. *R.I.P. Eliza Hart*. New York, NY, Scholastic Inc, 2017.

Summary: Ellie Sokoloff is attending Ventana Ranch School in Big Sur because she hopes that the wide-open setting will cure her claustrophobia and she was delighted to find Eliza Hart, her childhood friend, also in attendance. But Eliza has changed and for no apparent reason starts spreading rumors about Ellie, until one day she is found dead--now Ellie must find out what happened to her one-time best friend, and who killed her, not least because she herself is everybody's chief suspect.


FIC WAT



Watkins, Steve. *On blood road*. New York, Scholastic Press, 2018.

Summary. Taylor is a rebellious teenager with a habit of sneaking out to hang with his anti-war friends, so in January 1968 his mother drags him off to Saigon where his father is attached to the United States embassy; bored (and still rebellious) Taylor sneaks out of the embassy to watch the Tet celebrations, just as the war erupts all over Vietnam and there he is captured by the North Vietnamese Army and sent North as a prisoner and hostage--and during the brutal journey Taylor is forced to confront the realities of war and survival for the first time in his sheltered life.




Bendis, Brian. *Miles Morales Spider-man*.

Holm, Jennifer L. *Sunny rolls the dice*. New York, Graphix, an imprint of Scholastic, 2019.


