

ART MATERIAL SUPPLY LIST -- SWAC

BRUSHES:

Synthetic **SOFT**, natural or white color “hair” (or sable natural hair brushes)

#10 or #12 “Round” Tip Soft hair brush

¼” flat head brush

½” flat head brush

#2 or #3 detail brush or “Rigger” brush

PAPER:

Recommended: Arches “Cold Press” 140 lb. block pad or individual (22 x 30”) sheets

- You can make four 16” x 20” sheets from this one sheet of watercolor paper

NOTE: Block pad no smaller than 16 x 20”

or, Strathmore acid free, cold press paper in tablet or sheet

or, *Fluid* Watercolor Paper block, 16” x 20” – available on Amazon

WATERCOLOR PAINT TUBES:

Grumbacher Academy brand paints – least expensive

Available on Amazon, Dick Blick online store or Cheap Joe’s online store

Colors:

2 RED: Alizarin Crimson and Cadmium Red Deep

2 YELLOW: Lemon Yellow and Cadmium Yellow Medium

2 BLUE: Ultramarine Blue and Thalo Blue

3 NEUTRALS: Payne’s Gray, Chinese White and Van Dyke Brown

2 RED: Cadmium Red or Pyrrol (warm) & Quinacridone Rose or Alizarin
Crimson (cool)
2 YELLOW: Hansa or Lemon Yellow (cool) & Cadmium Yellow Med or Deep
(warm)
2 BLUE: Phthalo Blue or Peacock Blue (warm) & Cobalt Blue or Ultramarine Blue
(cool)
3 NEUTRALS: Titanium White, Payne's Gray & Vandyke Brown

MATERIALS FOR SPECIFIC CLASSES

- Colored Pencil & Watercolor:
 - *Prismacolor* non-water soluble colored pencils – 36 count tin
Available on Amazon

- Ink & Watercolor Washes:
 - Medium tip black (not permanent) ink pen (no Sharpies!) –
provided by instructor!

- Unexpected tools in Watercolor:
 - Bubble wrap, salt, rubbing alcohol, plastic lace, plastic mesh,
yarn, drinking straw, credit card, stencils, stamps, instant coffee.
Instructor will provide even more fun tools!

space

Sponges: natural sea sponge, clay modeling or inexpensive make-up sponge
