

Dressmaking Skill Builder – Lined Jacket AT3/AAG

Requirements:

- Approx. 3 metres (150cm/60" wide) medium weight Cotton (non stretch) fabric
 -ideally with a distinctive right and wrong side (this is not essential), but if not please
 ensure the fabric is light in colour to write on.
 Plain fabric would be better but patterned fabric is acceptable
 The fabric does not all have to be the same if you'd like to use up remnants of fabric,
 also consider recycling household fabrics i.e. duvet cover/sheets.
- Iron on lightweight Interfacing (approx. 1m)
- 2m lining fabric any colour
- 2m of piping cord (ideally size 1 but any size is acceptable)
- 1 x 15cm/6" zip (can have metal or plastic teeth)
- 1 pair of shoulder pads optional
- Approx. 2m of Pattern Paper/Tracing Paper/Brown Paper or similar
- Basic Sewing Kit including thread, scissors, pins, hand sewing needle, tape measure/ruler, tailors chalk or fabric pen
- A Standard Zipper Foot to fit your sewing machine
- A ring binder or similar to keep all your stitched samples together

You will receive a 'pack' by post prior to the first class of the course including all the paper pattern pieces you will require to complete the tasks. Please ensure York Learning has your up to date postal address. Please note the 'pack' does not include any fabrics etc. listed above – you need to source these yourself.

Your Sewing Machine should be all threaded up prior to the Zoom session ready to go!

Please note your Sewing Machine should be in good working order – unfortunately there will be no time during the session to fix any problems.
