

Volunteer Rules

All volunteers are expected to follow these rules to ensure the organization runs safely, respectfully, and effectively.

1. Respect and Conduct

- Treat all participants, volunteers, and leadership with respect
 - Maintain a positive and professional attitude
 - No discrimination, harassment, or disruptive behavior is allowed
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2. Responsibility

- Fulfill all assigned tasks for your role
 - Arrive on time and prepared for events or sessions
 - Inform leadership in advance if you cannot attend
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3. Communication

- Stay active and responsive in official communication channels
 - Follow instructions from leadership and event coordinators
 - Ask questions if anything is unclear instead of guessing
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4. Participation

- Be willing to help where needed, especially during events
 - Stay engaged during assigned activities
 - Follow event structure and role assignments
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5. Professionalism

- Represent the organization positively at all times
- Do not act in a way that damages the organization's reputation
- Keep conversations and behavior appropriate during events

6. Safety and Guidelines

- Follow all safety instructions during in-person and online events
- Do not take actions that could put participants at risk
- Report any issues or concerns to leadership immediately

7. Accountability

- Take responsibility for your assigned role
- Complete tasks to the best of your ability
- Accept feedback and make improvements when needed

Failure to follow these rules may result in warnings or removal from volunteer positions depending on severity.
