
- Open: 3:30 AM - 8:00 PM (Monday through Friday)

The water filtered fountain is located near the elevator.

Kitchen and Kitchenette

There is a full kitchen in the 730 Commons and a small Kitchenette in 709 the Atrium. Both have Keurig Coffee machines and electric kettles for your use. Students are responsible for purchasing K-Cups and tea. Microwaves and toasters have been ordered. There are also 3 refrigerators available. Amazon and USPS are delivered to the package room on the first floor. The package room is located on the south side of the building near the back door. Other packages will be delivered to suite 700. You are responsible to pick up your packages.

Large Deliveries

If you are making or receiving any large deliveries, you must use one of two freight elevators. If you are ordering large items, such as lumber, **you MUST be present for its delivery. If you are not present, the order cannot be received.** We have an A-frame, a pallet jack, and multiple carts available for you to borrow in the wood and metal shops. Carts are not allowed in the passenger elevators.

Wi-Fi

The strongest Wi-Fi on the 7th floor is PrattSecure5G, particularly for video calls or streaming.

Pfizer Resources

Woodshop

The Wood Shop will open on August 26th, 2025. **You must follow the posted rules regarding safety at all times.** The hours for the Woodshop are as follows:

A technician will be present during these hours for instructional support. The shop will close from 12pm to 1pm everyday for lunch but tool check out is still available. **If you have any questions on the operation of any machine, always ask the technician before using.** We have various hand tools for check out. Please remember that this is a shared resource. We ask that you prioritize safety, respect and cleanliness.

Metal Shop

The metal shop is a work in progress. If you have inquiries about using the metal shop, please reach out to Rebecca Erde (rerde@pratt.edu). *There will be no welding at Pfizer.*

Plaster Room

We have a Plaster and mold making room available Monday-Friday 9am-5pm. Please ask a technician or Rebecca to let you in.

Spray Booth

There is 24 hour access to the Spray Booth in room 706. Follow the signs to turn the filtration booth on. **You may only use Water-based paints.** Remember to let your

paint off-gas prior to bringing it to your studio. **Please clean up after yourself and avoid spraying the clear plastic curtains around the machine.**

Sewing Machine

There is a sewing machine for general use located in 709. You must supply your own materials. Please contact Christina Thurston, Operations Manager, Fashion (cthursto@pratt.edu) before using it the first time to review operational rules.

Printing

Two printers (8.5"x11" and 11"x17") are now installed in Room 724 next to the Fashion Office in the West Studios and in Studio 21 in the South Studios. Printing is free.

Students must supply their own paper which will work with a laser printer. Do not attempt to print on materials that may damage the printer. You can sign into the computer at either station to print. Please notify me (rerde@pratt.edu) if the printer is out of ink or is malfunctioning.

Plotter

There are two plotters available for use at Pfizer in Studio 21 in the South Studios. The paper is 36" wide. Paper and ink are supplied by Pratt. Please notify me (rerde@pratt.edu) if the either plotter is out of ink or is malfunctioning.

Laser Cutter

The new Universal Laser Cutter will be available starting November 17th. The laser cutter will be on Q-Reserve once it is ready. You must be trained prior to making an appointment. Sign up for a training appointment.

Appointment Policies:

If you have not taken our one-hour Laser Certification course, you will not have access to Laser Cut appointments.

Any unbooked appointments are open for walk-ins.

If you are more than 15 minutes late to your appointment, your time slot will be forfeited and your machine will be open for walk-ins.

Walk-In Policies:

Walk-in appointments are available for the laser if it's not booked.

Walk-ins are allowed one hour on their assigned machine or until the next appointment arrives.

Photo Studio

The Photo Studio (in room 713) is open to all current students and active faculty in the School of Design and the School of Architecture. The large seamless backdrop is 103" wide and the smaller seamless is 53" wide with 3 color options: white, black or gray. The space is equipped with dedicated daylight balanced LED continuous-lights on light stands with soft-box light modifiers. There is 24 hour access. **You can reserve the Photo Studio on [Q-Reserve](#).**

3D Printing

We are excited to offer self-service 3D Printing at Pfizer located in Studio 22. We

have 1 Bambu Carbon x1 and 2 Prusa i3 MK3S+. Please see below for how to sign up and use it.

- 3D Printing is free but you must provide your own filament
- Filament must be 1.75mm diameter
- PLA and TPU are allowed on these printers. If you are using TPU on the Bambu, you must remove the Bowdon tube on the back of the machine. Please ask for help if you are unsure how to do this.
- The 3D Printer is located in Studio 22, across from my office
- You may only use the printers for 24 hours and you are not allowed to reserve the printers for 2 days in a row
- **You can reserve the three 3D printers on [Q-Reserve](#)**

We are implementing new rules for the printers. If you are 30 minutes late, you are considered a no-show. After 3 no-shows, you will lose access to reserving and can only do walk-ins.
