

Benjamin Shannon is making a serious indent into the Australian and International music scene as a percussionist, educator, curator and composer. Hailing from Nambour on the Sunshine Coast, Ben has studied with world renowned percussionists Mark Guiliana, Dave Elitch, Ian Chang, Jeff Friedl, Danny Heifitz, Tim Firth, Andrew Gander, Simon Barker, John Parker and Paul Hudson.

He has performed alongside Pulitzer, ARIA and Grammy award winning artists in Raven Chacon, Jane Sibbery, Scott Tinkler, Marc Ducret, Eiichi Hayashi, Robin Eubanks, Francois Salque, Yitzhak Yedid, Kristin Berardi, Toby Wren, and Martin Kay, summarising an extensive list. Ben and his projects have supported the likes of the Sun Ra Arkestra, Ryosuke Kiyasu, The Contortionist, Leprous, Voyager, COG, We Lost The Sea, Delta Sleep, The Black Sorrows, Katatonia, Troy Cassar-Daley and more.

Ben's compositions have received critical acclaim (Bell Award's Young Jazz Award Finalist 2019, Queensland Music Awards Finalist 2020, 2022, 2024, Art Music Awards 2022, 2023) and his work has received support from Creative Australia, Arts Queensland and Moreton Bay Regional Council. Ben was also nominated for the Freedman Jazz Award in 2020 and 2023 and was awarded the APRA AMCOS Art Music Fund award in 2026.

Original projects of Ben's include Milton Man Gogh, Shamin, Kodiak Empire, Brisbane Conduction Orchestra, Dropbear Lodge, Big Dead, Milk Buttons, Spirit Lights, Soul Mechanics, and more. Since 2013 he has released over 20 albums and toured nationally and internationally with a multitude of groups.

Ben took part in the Banff International Jazz Workshop, in Banff, Canada, in August 2017, August 2024, and the Banff Musicians In Residence Program in January 2024. He also was accepted into the Australian Art Orchestra Creative Intensive Music Program in August of 2018 where he engaged in cross-cultural workshops, performances and rehearsals with musicians from Arnhem Land, Korea, England and across Australia and learnt from some of Australia's most reputable Art/Experimental Music artists.

In early 2017, Ben was asked to join iconic Sydney based label, Art As Catharsis, to help with bookings and administration for the Brisbane side of things. His other roles include meeting with potential clients, discussing and contributing to general label plans, online exposure and promotion.

Ben also conducts and directs an improvised orchestra, The Brisbane Conduction Orchestra, from methods and practices he learned from his time in Banff, from Tyshawyn Sorey. This is a community oriented Orchestra that champions diversity, inclusion and a safe improvisational environment.

Ben is heavily involved in the Australian contemporary jazz and experimental scene promoting gigs and tours for Qais Essar, Michel Gasco, KNOWER, Rafiq Bhatia, Hubris. and many other Australian and International acts since 2014. He has booked countless gigs and tours for classical, jazz, rock, experimental and world outfits since 2011 across all parts of

Australia. He has generated a strong network of venues/musicians/publicists/radio from the ground up through his relentless appetite to foster original exciting projects in Australia.

He also began studying the Tabla in 2016 under the direction of guru ji Shen Flindell and looks to incorporate new found eastern styles and techniques to the drum kit, composition and teaching.

Since 2018 Ben has featured in a number of television commercials and movies both drumming and acting. He is represented by Howell Management.

Ben recently graduated Honours (1st Class) at the Queensland Conservatorium of Music, and has commenced his PhD in 2025, oriented around The Art of Conduction. He currently holds a Bachelor of Music in Jazz Drums and a Graduate Diploma of Secondary Education. Ben is devoted to the Australian experimental/improvised scene and seeks to push and nurture the sound of Australian improvised music. Ben also runs a teaching studio out of Brisbane and is available for lessons in drum kit, percussion and composition.
