Goals by Level (Elementary, Middle, and High School)

Elementary Goal Example

By the end of the 2016-2017 school year bus referrals for misconduct for students in grades kindergarten through second grade will decrease. This will be attained through the use of a behavior modification program that will be put in place by elementary school counselors and transportation staff no later than January 4, 2017. This plan will allow students to demonstrate self-discipline and self-control. In comparing bus referrals, from the current school year, before and after the initiation of the program, results will show a 20% decrease in the number of students receiving a disciplinary referral by May 26, 2017.

Middle School Goal Example: By June 2017, the number of 6th-8th grade students identified by the Early Warning Systems (EWS) list (*432 students) will increase passing rate in English Language Arts and/or Mathematics by 5 percentage points from 82% baseline [354 passing/432 students] to a minimum of 86.1% [376 passing/432 students]. *432 students are due to 9 EWS students enrolling over the school year.

H.S. Goal Example: (Achievement & Attendance Goal:)By May of 2017, the class of 2019 will increase the percentage of students on track to graduate by 7% from 87% to 94%.
