• How did a personal interest lead you to this learning and product goal? • What exactly is your learning goal and product goal? • What specific research topics did you explore to help you with your learning? • What research do you still need to do? • How is your research informing your next steps on the project? • What logistics are necessary to consider e.g. materials, budget, resources, etc.? • What is a realistic timeline for this project?	• How has your research helped you with planning the personal project and your success criteria? • Do you believe your success criteria is realistic? Does it need to be revised? • Are you on track for finishing your project by February 15th? Are you meeting your deadlines on your timeline? Does your timeline need to be revised? • Are you fully documenting your experience of the process e.g. pictures, charts, notes, video, etc.? • What do you need to tweak or revise? • Do you still need more materials? What was challenging about the process? • What new information did you learn through this process about your topic? • What do you think could have improved in your paper and product if you had more time?
