Scenario	You work in a large salon in the nails department, and your supervisor has decided that you should take a course in nail art to equip you with the knowledge and skills necessary to provide exceptional service that leaves a positive impression on your clients. In this course, you will review the essential tools and equipment needed to deliver outstanding nail art services, and you will learn how to use them effectively to achieve the best results. You will also be introduced to a variety of nail art techniques, allowing you to choose the ones that best fit your style and your clients' preferences. Additionally, you will review the techniques of this art in depth, with a focus on personal performance to ensure you master all the required skills. To successfully complete the course and obtain the certificate, you must fulfil the following tasks:
Task 1	As part of the course, you are required to prepare a document that includes the following information 1- State the importance of using products, tools, equipment: You should provide a statement that outlines the importance of choosing the appropriate

products, tools, and equipment to effectively meet clients' needs.

- 2- **Describe the methods of preparation for nail art services:** Provide a detailed description of the preparation methods necessary to deliver nail art services professionally.
- 3- **Describe the Contraindications and Precautions:** Provide a detailed description of contraindications or precautions that may prevent or restrict the provision of nail art, and how to handle them.
- 4- **Explain of the Suitability of Preparation Procedures Through:**
 - ☐ Selecting the necessary products, tools, and equipment for nail art.
 - ☐ Clarifying the tools used to achieve specific nail art techniques.
 - ☐ Identifying the direct impact of incorrect preparation procedures and the effects they can have on the client/salon.

Evidence: A document outlining the standards in the form of a poster or leaflet describing the different nail art tools and equipment, including a range of images showing a variety of nail art designs.

- 5- **Assess the Impact of Preparation Procedures and the Suitability of Nail Art Products on the Client Through:**
 - ☐ Evaluate the positive and negative impacts that incorrect procedures can have on a client.
 - ☐ Discuss whether contraindications are noted before the nail art service and how these should be treated
 - ☐ Review the appropriateness of the nail art requested by clients and if the nail art can have a negative effect upon a client's hands.

Task 2

You have been asked to work according to professional standards in comprehensive preparation regarding yourself, your clients, and the work area, and to adhere to salon policies and safe and hygienic practices at all times. You have also been asked to design and showcase your nail art designs to several participants in the course. Therefore, you need to complete the following:

A) Implement nail art techniques and provide aftercare advice to a group of clients, while paying attention to the quality of the final nail art through:

- ☐ **Preparing the Work Area and Sanitizing Tools:** Carefully prepare the work area and ensure that all tools and equipment are sanitized before starting to provide nail art services, in addition to preparing yourself and the client.
- ☐ **Consulting with Clients:** Provide consultations for three clients to assist them in choosing suitable nail art designs.
- ☐ **Selecting Appropriate Tools, Equipment, and Products:** select the necessary tools, equipment, and products based on each client's chosen design.
- ☐ **Carry out Nail Decoration Techniques:** Carry out various nail art techniques for the three clients using a variety of nail products through:
 - 1- A document containing a brief description of five designs for nail art techniques.
 - 2- Applying at least three of these techniques on the three clients.
 - 3- Attaching a student observation record (which includes the three clients).
 - 4- Attaching photographic evidence of the nail art designs.

- ☐ **Providing Aftercare Advice:** Offer aftercare advice to the three clients to ensure the longevity of the results.
- ☐ **Paying Attention to the Quality of the Final Nail Art.**

- ☐ **Providing Recommendations for Improvement:** Evaluate your performance and how you interact and communicate with clients, and how you can enhance your performance in the future.
