Need to take the ACT? Register at www.act.org. Please remember that you must bring your testing ticket and ID in order to take the test. Student IDs are accepted. Calculators are not provided.

- Take the ACT early and often. If 11th or 12th grade students are on free or reduced lunch up to two (2) fee waivers may be available to take the ACT.
- Ask for feedback on what you missed on ACT so you can improve. Many scholarships are dependent on this exam.
- Take AP classes the rigor helps to prepare you.
- Do well in math since college algebra is one of the classes that stump students.

Each year, Ozarks Electric Cooperative sends two area high school juniors to visit Washington, D.C. at no charge to the student. This program, called Youth Tour, is sponsored by electric cooperatives all over the nation. Youth Tour was created to allow students the opportunity to visit our nation's capital and see firsthand how our government works.

The selection process for Youth Tour 2020 is currently underway. Interested students will choose one of the two projects listed in the Youth Tour guidelines. Winners will be selected based on their project and interview. This year's Youth Tour will be held June 19-25. The application deadline is February 1. Scroll

Windgate Scholarship

The Windgate Scholarship is specifically for incoming freshmen students. The Scholarship is based on creative talent and financial need and can be worth up to \$2,000 per semester in the freshman year and can increase up to \$1,000 each year so that in the senior year up to \$5,000 per semester may be awarded. To be eligible, students must return a completed application form with requested materials, plan to declare art as their major, and attend UCA.. As noted on the form, the deadline for mailing the application materials is March 20th and the deadline for submission of FAFSA information is March 6th.
