## SECTION 2: IMPORTANT GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION FOR ADMISSION

### Admission General Guideline

- 1) 1st year admission of Undergraduate Programme in Malda College for academic session 2025-2026 is commencing through **Centralised Admission Portal** (An Initiative of The West Bengal State Council of Higher Education). [Click Here for Portal link](#).
- 2) Candidates seeking admission must have to secure the qualifying pass marks including English at the Higher Secondary (H.S.), or its equivalent Examination.
- 3) During admission, the marks of the best **four** subjects at the Higher Secondary (H.S.), or its equivalent Examination will be considered. These four best subjects must include **English**.
- 4) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous 4 years, **i.e., 2026, 2025, 2024, 2023, 2022** will only be allowed to take admission.

- 6) Applications from the candidates passed through Distance mode of Education will NOT be entertained.

### Main Focus of NEP2020

- ❖ Although this course is of four years, all the students have to study the same syllabus for the first three years.
- ❖ Honours or research with honors in the 4th year will be determined if the candidate gets the specified marks as per university norms in the examination at the end of the third year.
- ❖ If a student wants to discontinue his/her study after the first year, he/she must inform this to college at the beginning of **2nd Sem** and he/she must complete the process of Internship. Then He/she will be eligible to get **Certificate** from university on completion of the first year.

- ❖ If a student wants to discontinue his/her study after the 2nd year, he/she must inform this to college at the beginning of **4th Sem** and he/she must complete the process of Internship. Then He/she will be eligible to get **Diploma** from university on completion of the 2nd year.
- ❖ If a student wants to discontinue his/her study after the 3rd year, he/she must inform this to college at the beginning of **6th Sem**. Then He/she will be eligible to get **UG Degree** from university on completion of the 3rd year.
- ❖ At the end of four years, the University will award the 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research) degree.

**Students taking this course should study the following Category of subjects:**

- a) Major Core (MJ) Courses,
  - b) Minor Core (MN) Courses,
  - c) Multi Disciplinary (MDC) Courses,
  - d) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC),
  - e) Ability Enhancement Compulsory (AEC) Courses,
  - f) Value addition Courses (VAC),
  - g) Internship / Apprenticeship / Workshop / Project / Community Outreach Courses (IAPWC)
- ❖ In Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Semester System you have to get fixed credit points in eight semesters for four years. A student can opt for research subject in the fourth year if he fulfils all the specified conditions [Students of 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honors with Research) course who secure certain marks specified by University in the first six semesters and wish to pursue research at graduate level in the fourth year One can choose a research stream. ]
  - ❖ Once the program (B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A) is specified the program cannot be changed without the permission of the prescribed authority of the University.
  - ❖ After admission registration for Academic Bank of Credits [(ABC) through <http://www.abc.gov.in>] should be done on the specified portal.

### **Major, Minor & MDC Subject Combination for BA/BSC/BCOM**

Every student studies one Major subject from subject-1 Column & one Minor subject from Subject -2 column and one MDC from Subject-3 column mentioned below table. **The selection of Minor and MDC subjects at the central Portal will be finalised on the basis of infrastructure and availability of seats of the subjects at College.** In addition with Multi Disciplinary (MDC) Courses, Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Ability Enhancement Compulsory (AEC) Courses, Value Addition Courses (VAC), Internship/ Apprenticeship / Project / Workshop / Community Outreach Courses (IAPWC) must be studies.

8. Students must get registered through the university portal for obtaining **University Registration Number** and submit the Acknowledgement Slip for approval in the college office (Room No. 106). Since the University portal remains active for a limited time period, students should follow the college website for relevant notice in this regard.
9. Registered Students should check the university portal for obtaining **Admit Card** after university exam form fill up and submit the Acknowledgement Slip and Payment Slip for approval in the college office (Room No. 106). Since the University portal remains active for a limited time period, students should follow the college website for relevant notice in this regard.
10. Payment must be paid through the College **ERP system through student login** using Student Id and Password provided after admission. You should install **Malda College Android Apps** from Play store for getting regular updates.

## Some Other Important Notes after admission

1. You must use your registered mobile number and email address to access the "Student login" College Portal. Install the Malda College Android Apps from the Play Store to receive regular updates. If you need to alter your phone number or email address, please come to room 106 during office hours.
2. Students are required to bring their student identity cards to college on a regular basis and to produce them when required. The loss of an identity card must be reported immediately to the office, and it will be replaced upon payment of the associated fees. The card must be submitted to the college office in the event of a transfer or withdrawal from the college.
3. **Regular class attendance** is compulsory for every student of the College for getting internal marks as per university norms.
4. A student will be considered as Non-collegiate, if her/his attendance in any subject / group of subjects falls short of 75% but not below 60%. Candidates declared Non-collegiate may be allowed to fill in application forms for examination on payment of requisite Non-collegiate fees.
5. The **Anti-ragging Cell** of the college is very strong to function in every respect and students are sworn never to rag. Fortunately, no case of ragging in any form has occurred so far. 10. Students should maintain a sense of decorum at all times both inside and outside the College. Those who are found guilty of serious misconduct may invite punishment, including expulsion as permitted by regulations.

## Facilities/Activities of Malda College: Central Library

Malda College Library began its existence in 1944. Since then it has grown in size and content along with the college to take the present shape. All these years the library has been the life-line for the academic activity of the institute. It is well established and not only caters to the needs of the undergraduate students, but also the postgraduate students, research scholars and the faculty. It is the main source of knowledge and also the integral part of the institution. It is housed in a separate building having three floors of which the ground floor is known as Department of Geography and the first & second floor is the present library on an area about 808



sq.m. The second floor of the library was constructed with the assistance of RUSA grants in the year of 2017. The library has a collection of more than 42850 print volumes which includes Text Books, Reference Books, Magazines and Journals. Library housekeeping operation is automated using 'KOHA Software' (an Open Source Library Management Software). The book database is accessible through OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue).

## Wall Magazines and E-Magazines:



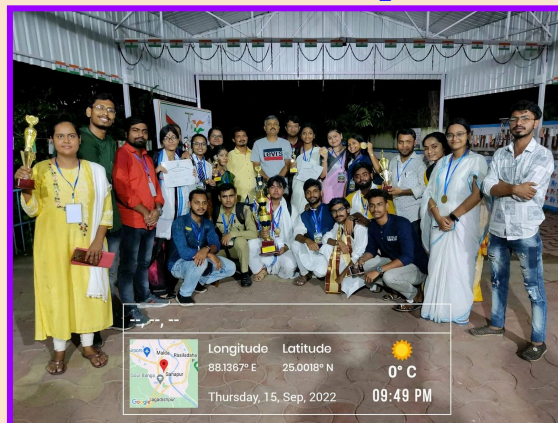
