MARKET OVERVIEW

A thoughtfully curated event for vintage lovers and conscious shoppers.

The Market H91 celebrates vintage and preloved fashion alongside handmade and creative traders, vintage homeware, vinyl, and carefully selected food and treat tables.

Only vintage and preloved clothing is permitted. No fast fashion including Shein, Primark, Temu, or AliExpress. High street pieces must be in excellent condition, clean, and of good quality.

VENUE INFORMATION

Electric Galway is a fully operating nightclub. The venue has nightclub-style lighting and an atmospheric setting, which is part of the character of the market. Lighting is lower than in a traditional market hall, so vendors are strongly encouraged to bring additional lighting. Extension leads are recommended, and displays should be clear, visible, and well lit.

All market related queries must be directed to The Market organisers, not the venue.

MARKET HOURS

The market is open to the public from 11.30am to 5.00pm.

Vendor set up takes place between 10.30am and 11.30am. Entry before 10.30am is strictly not permitted. All stalls must be fully packed down and cleared by 6.00 pm.

Vendors may arrive after the set-up period has begun; however, all stalls **must be fully set up and ready to trade by the time the doors open to the public.**

Later set up beyond public opening time is not permitted. Early closure or pack down before the official market end time is not permitted unless prior approval has been given by the organisers. Failure to adhere to these timings may affect future applications.

STALL OPTIONS AND PRICES

Stall Fees

Single space (1 rail or 1 table) — €40

Standard space (2 rails, 1 rail & 1 table, or 2 tables) — €60

Large space (3 rails) — €80

Vendors must bring their own rails and tables.

Stalls may be shared by a maximum of two vendors and must be agreed in advance.

STALL GUIDELINES

Vendors must bring their own rails and tables. All stock must be pre approved in advance. Stalls must be manned for the full duration of the market, with a maximum of two people per stall. Stalls should be clean, tidy, and professionally always presented. Vendors are responsible for taking all stock, props, and rubbish with them at the end of the day. Toilets may be used as changing rooms if needed. Cashless payment options are strongly recommended.

STALL PRESENTATION

€5 rails, bargain bins, and sale signage are not permitted. Handwritten or unprofessional signage is not allowed. Free piles, giveaways, or flash sales are not permitted. Clothing must not be placed on the floor and should always be properly displayed. All items must have clear and visible pricing. Printed signage and price tags are required. Where applicable, your business name or logo should be clearly displayed. Tables must be covered, ideally with floor length cloth. Boxes, bags, and excess stock should be neatly hidden from view. All clothing must be hung neatly and professionally.

PAYMENTS ON THE DAY

Vendors are encouraged to offer cashless payment options such as SumUp, Revolut, or PayPal. QR codes or usernames should be clearly displayed where possible. Bringing a small float is recommended as a backup.

All payments must be made directly at your stall.

MARKET DAY ESSENTIALS

Please ensure you bring a payment device and a float, along with suitable carry bags for customers. Hangers, signage, and price tags should be prepared in advance. Vendors are responsible for bringing a rubbish bag and taking all waste home. An extension lead and additional lighting are strongly recommended due to the nightclub style venue. A table cover should be used, ideally floor length. Mirrors or small props may be brought to enhance your display if desired.

PACK DOWN AND CLEAN UP

All signage must be removed at pack down. Sellotape must not be used on walls or furniture. Vendors are responsible for taking everything with them, including stock, props, and rubbish. Your space should be left exactly as it was found.

PARKING AND ACCESS

There is no parking available directly outside the venue. Vendors may unload quickly only and must not block the road. Nearby parking is available at Q Park Hynes Yard, Q Park Eyre Square, Bowling Green Car Park, and Market Street Car Park.

PROMOTION

The event is actively promoted across multiple channels and is supported by This is Galway, one of Galway's largest online platforms, with over 220,000 combined followers and a monthly reach of over 2 million. They will be attending on the day to capture content and share the atmosphere. Electric Galway are also promoting the event through their channels, adding further visibility.

Branding & Promotion

Please use the official Market flyer provided when promoting the event. If creating your own graphics or posts, we kindly ask that the **official The Market H91 logo** be used, rather than recreating or adding the market name manually.

This helps us keep branding clear and consistent across all promotions.

WHAT ELSE CAN I SELL? Bags, shoes, jewellery, and accessories are welcome if they are vintage, preloved, or handmade.

The Market organisers do not accept liability for loss, theft, or damage. Vendors trade at their own risk and are responsible for their own stalls and stock at all times.
