Abstract. The heading Abstract should be typed in bold 9-point Arial, followed immediately by the abstract text in normal 9-point Times New Roman, with single line spacing. The abstract should be centred across the page. The abstract must be written in English and presented as a single paragraph not exceeding 200 words. It should concisely summarize the background, objective, methods, main results, and conclusion of the study, with emphasis on clear and data-driven findings.
