Call for Nominations - Deadline January 7, 2020

Nominations may be submitted by colleagues, students, former students, parents, administrators or the general public. *Before beginning the nomination, please check with teacherofyear@fccps.org* by December 6, 2019 to confirm that the individual is eligible.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

Nominees must be teachers who:

- ❖ Instill in students a desire to learn and achieve.
- ❖ Understand the individual needs of students, encourage their talents, and foster their self-esteem.
- Demonstrate a thorough knowledge of subject matter and the ability to share it effectively with students.
- Foster cooperative relationships with their colleagues and the community.
- Demonstrate outstanding leadership.

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominees must be full-time teachers in pre-kindergarten grade 12
- Teachers may not nominate themselves or encourage others to do so.
- Nominees must have completed at least five years of service in FCCPS.
- Nominees must maintain teaching position throughout the 2020-2021 school year.
- ❖ Past recipients of a Teacher of the Year award are eligible to be nominated if their award was received more than 10 years ago. <u>List of previous winners.</u>

SUBMISSION

- ❖ Letter from Principal is required in each nomination packet.
- Nominations can be submitted via email or print by Friday, January 3, 2020.
