

State Statistics Service of Ukraine (SSSU)

The State Statistics Service of Ukraine (SSSU) operates under the supervision of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. It is responsible for collecting, processing, and disseminating official statistical data to support government decision-making and policy development.

The SSSU plays an indirect but important role in climate policy by providing statistical data that supports environmental monitoring, policy development, and international reporting.

SSSU collects and publishes data on various environmental and economic indicators, including:

- Energy consumption and efficiency, which helps assess carbon emissions and energy transition progress.
- Industrial production and emissions, relevant for tracking greenhouse gas outputs.
- Agricultural statistics, including land use and resource management, which impact climate adaptation strategies.
- Environmental and energy indicators, supporting Ukraine's commitments to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
