Step-by-Step Directions

Step 1: The Hook (30 seconds – 1 minute)

- Begin with a high-energy, engaging hook to grab the audience's attention.
- Include a call and response, movement, or another dynamic technique.
- Make sure to introduce yourself within the hook.
- Must be no less than 30 seconds and no more than 1 minute.

Step 2: The Presentation (Please note in the video I say this Step needs to be exactly 5 minutes, I have corrected this - Step 2 can be no less than 4 minutes not more than 5 minutes.)

- Choose one area of *resilience* that you could speak about confidently (e.g., self-worth, boundaries, body image, relationships, grades, sports, etc.).
- Share your personal experience with this area. **Do not** pick something you don't have lived experience in.
- Break the presentation into three parts:
 1. **Introduction** of the topic – ideally through a game, dialogue, or activity (e.g., “Put a Finger Down” game).
 2. **Personal Story** – describe the challenge you faced and how you overcame it. Relate it to that age group.
 3. **Tangible Strategy** – give students a concrete takeaway or activity to help them with the same issue (e.g., a perspective shift exercise).



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Step 3: The Closing (30 seconds – 1 minute)

- End with inspiration, motivation, or a clear call to action.
- Keep it between 30 seconds and 1 minute.

Important Notes:

- Present as if you're in front of a live group of **9th–12th graders**.
- Stay fully in character — perform it like it's the real deal.
- Make it actionable, tangible, and relatable.
