- A. Meeting called to order at 8:31am.
- B. Gratitudes & Questions
 - a. Danceathon was a \$ success/hit their goal to cover Field Day.
 - b. New homework/technology policies
 - i. Backlash from some teachers and parents.
 - How this is being interpreted and implemented is varying across all classrooms. We need to make sure everyone is getting the right/clear message.
 - c. 8th Grade Dance
 - i. Fewer than 20 students attended.
 - ii. Need to have this on the calendar from the beginning of the year/included in Weekly starting the month before.
 - iii. We will try to plan dances around outside activities/potentially find a better time of year.

C. Presidents' Update

- a. Budget
 - i. Have tried to fine-tune budget over the last couple of years.
 - ii. Take a look and review your line items.
 - iii. Presidents and Lara are getting together with Dr. Brown this month to come up with the right financial ask for PTA next year. \$95 was not sufficient. Hoping to have the number by next meeting.
- b. DLA Meeting
 - i. Considering a financial one-ask (combining Spark/PTA) to simplify things. Still putting together a team to evaluate.
- c. PTA Board Job Descriptions
 - i. Review if you haven't.
 - ii. Lara (Treasurer), Kristin (Financial Secretary) and Erin (½ of Hospitality) are moving on. Elisa will take Erin's role next year.
 - iii. We will post open roles in the Hall (and NC/Cove) Sunday Weekly. Parliamentarian, Lost and Found, 6th Grade Rep are open.
 - iv. If PTA isn't paying for sports next year, will we even need to be involved/have a Programs Rep?
 - 1. RevTrak is an option going forward, ideally linked to TeamSnap. It should be one step for parents to sign up/pay for the season.
 - 2. Need to meet with the Athletic Director to discuss.
- D. Teacher Rep Update
 - a. Track & Field: 80 athletes signed up.
 - b. New Homework/Computer Usage Policies: many different opinions. Some teachers feeling attacked.

- c. Work Habits will now be included in report cards, starting Trimester 3.
 - Need to communicate to parents what "Work Habits" means, and also where the Homework Policy changes came from
 - 1. Citizenship grade will be empty starting T3 (included in Work Habits).

- a. Treasurer

 - 1. Very low response rate.
 - a. Perhaps survey fatigue. Should we consolidate surveys?
 - 2. Hall: low ratings for teacher communication.
 - 3. Does school support academic growth? Low percentage for Hall, NC and Cove.
 - a. Low CASP scores. Need to make changes to improve this.
 - 4. Does school support social-emotional growth? Spike this year for Hall (88%).
 - 5. We need to address the consistency across classrooms (starting in elementary school) and grade levels.
 - ii. Dr. Geithman will respond to concerns about academics that have been brought up.
 - 1. Frustration with academics has existed for a long time.
 - 2. Growth Mindset should be primary focus.
