### PE/School Uniform

This Session the teachers would like to continue with the children coming to school dressed in their PE kit on their PE days. The PE days are:

Can I also remind parents of the Aberdeenshire policy in regard to PE kits and especially football tops –

*'PE Kit consists of – T shirt which tucks into shorts, standard length shorts, socks, gym shoes (preferably with Velcro or elastic fastening for younger pupils) all kept in a gym bag. With regard to safety, the wearing of jewellery (which we actively discourage) is not permitted during PE lessons. If your child (boy or girl) has pierced ears, please ensure they can remove and replace earrings by themselves. Any child wearing earrings that*
