Land Trust Review

- No need to amend the current plan at this point
- Summer School Report: Participants in the reading group were able to get library cards as well as a book of choice from Barnes and Noble. Students participated in credit recovery (100 credits recovered). Credit recovery aide and math specialist were hired to help close the gap with students going to high school credit deficient.
- The students will be able to purchase items with Hero points, the program will be run by the marketing teacher and students
- Coaching is in place, teachers who want to attend conferences, etc are able to submit for funding through Land Trust money
- We are within less than 10% of our budget in carry-over

Friday Interventions: 2:30-3:30 on Fridays. We will start offering after school interventions on other nights if we find these are not enough. 84 students were called last week, 32 showed up. It is a logistics problem to ask the students who need to ride the bus home, they aren't able to get home in time to join the second session. Flex Fridays will be inviting students to come live to the school. Students are being invited to come into the school live, but students are also able to come into the school based on their personal needs even without an invitation

Fundraisers: Every year the school can hold two charitable fundraisers (last year they participated in Paws for a Cause with CHHS by holding Penny Wars)

- PTSA can do a fundraiser for memory books
- One fundraiser for School Community Council

Traffic concern: The crossing guards are stationed at a right turn on 8200 S which is causing the traffic at the right turn to be unable to make the turn. Crossing guards are not legally allowed to block and change the flow of traffic. Will request the SRO come and watch the morning drop-off.

Scheduling for this school year: We were unable to do a full block schedule like last year because of funding (it requires all teachers to have a prep on both days and we don't have the FTE to cover it). To give some of the opportunities allowed by block we are offering the current schedule. If there is no live school on Friday the Thursday before will be a full 7 period day. About half the other middle schools are on a modified block and half are doing a 7 period day.
