EFA Student Enrollment

Procedure

EFA students in the Newfound Area School District must work directly with the district administration to access programs, as there is no universal state-mandated *free* access for EFA students. The district has the authority to set its own policies and fees for participation. An EFA student residing in the Newfound Area School District cannot be enrolled in the EFA program and simultaneously attend Newfound Area public schools full-time. An EFA student residing outside of the Newfound Area School District may use EFA funds to access Newfound Area schools on a part-time or full-time basis.

Procedure for EFA Students to Access Curricular and Co-Curricular Programs

1. If a family is interested in having their EFA student participate in any Newfound curricular and/or co-curricular programming (including athletics), they should contact the Newfound Area School District administrative office (603-744-5555) or the administrative office at any of its schools and identify the specific course(s) or activity(ies) the student wishes to join.
2. The District and/or school will determine if there whether or not there is space or openings available in that particular program.
3. The EFA student must meet the same prerequisites as any other resident student (e.g., academic standing, tryouts for sports teams).
4. The family must submit a request in writing to the superintendent specifying which program(s) the student wishes to participate in.
5. If accepted, the family must follow the same registration requirements as resident students.
6. EFA students are subject to the same requirements and eligibility criteria as resident students for all programming.
7. The cost of participation in curricular programming will be the district's current tuition cost prorated based on the level of participation (i.e. number of courses).
8. The cost of participation in co-curricular activities and athletics is set by current tuition agreements in place with sending districts.
9. The family will pay these costs through the NH EFA portal on the DOE website.
