Google Voice

Google Voice will allow you to make and take phone calls or text messages on your personal cell phone, on your computer, or any android or mac tablet without having to give out your personal cell phone number. You'll be able to set office hours that dictate when you will and will not accept calls. This will also allow you to collect voicemails and voicemail transcripts.

Google Voice is NOT included in our BCSD Google for Education accounts.
YOU WILL NEED TO USE A PERSONAL GOOGLE ACCOUNT TO USE GOOGLE VOICE.
