Alternative Housing Solutions

We will create interactional spaces in our community that break down barriers for Homeless Veterans and Economic Refugee camp's seeking resettlement. Our alternative housing approach is a low cost solution to the homeless crisis. An Out of Service Public Transit Bus or Used/Donated Class A RV Motorhomes converted into mobilize restaurants for eating and mobilize Sleeping Shelters for the homeless and inclusive to dedicated transportation routes and Well Being docking HUB & Sleep stations strategically Nationwide. We are offering a 3 month on-boarding living and sleeping development pilot program.

With the help of the homeless population as our local guest in your communities, we can create a unique and mobilize space for homeless veterans by strategically converting Service Discontinued Public Transit Buses and Class A Motorhomes in an innovative way for the Homeless to eat and a alternative method for safely sleeping units for the homeless population. A temporary wellbeing station is assigned to each sleeping and eating unit.

We will work intensively with our guests and equip them with the tools they need to succeed at being self-sufficient when attempting resettlement back into Civil Society. We increase earning opportunities by providing employment to each occupying Sponsored resident-guest willing to live on-board by participating in our 3 month personal development program. Upon completion of the program we will provide each guest with permanent housing solutions and other opportunities related to a particular job experience. By giving back and working together as Team in our community we can create a happier neighborhood for the youth shaping generations to come after our work has been completed.

WE OFFER A 3 MONTH ON-BOARDING LIVING PROGRAM

1. Help overcome issues that lead to homelessness
2. Assist with mental & physical well-being
3. Assist guests in economic literacy, apprenticeships, vocational training, licensing/job development skills/small business startups.
4. Re-engage guests back into the community
5. Our unique venue provides opportunities for positive community interaction with our guests.

Civil Veterans Foundation Inc utilizes a branding partnership agreement from the Veteran Support Team of America "Booths on the Pavement" and "Event in Box" Housing and Employment program, with Private RV owners as Volunteer Team Drivers. This is a great opportunity in Sheltering alternatives for Veterans in our communities, by providing this Housing and Employment program method to your RV, it becomes a resolution to the crisis amongst our Homeless Veterans in America.

Our "Shelters On Wheels" program is a solution to this Homeless Veterans Crisis in America, we provide housing and employment solutions included with ground transportation through use of Recreational Vehicles, at no cost to our Team Members requiring Housing and Employment resources from our programs. Our Intake process is simple for New Team Members, whether you are volunteers or currently enrolled in both programs. With your help, by joining "The Civil Veterans Motor Club" your RV can provide the shortest distance between "A Home & A Hope" for sustainable employment, as well as sustainable housing .

We have developed a Nationwide Fundraising Campaign on wheels called "Veterans Are Great National Caravan Tours " . We are currently recruiting Class A Driver's, and RV owners nationwide to help organize Local Teams, Regional Team Divisions and Veteran Support Team Leaders, to become proud sponsors with the Veteran Support Team Managers mission in helping Team members get organized and start their own "SHELTERS ON WHEELS" program.

By providing temporary "Homeless Shelters on Wheels" and " Restaurant Cafe on Wheels" as a form of housing with transportation, is an all inclusive alternative approach to affordable housing that supports the homeless crisis in America. Our hope is to offer a little relief to increase change, by improving the lives of Homeless Veterans facing tough circumstances. Each individual Homeless Shelters on Wheels and Restaurant Cafe on Wheels will fulfill human rights, dignified living conditions, personal needs and family needs because unemployment and homelessness, are direct results from excessive rent burdens. Social class awareness categorizes the overall homeless populations to become Economic Refugees seeking an affordable resettlement. . Instead they're classified as Homeless Citizens of the United States of America.

Join our Team/Create Your Team

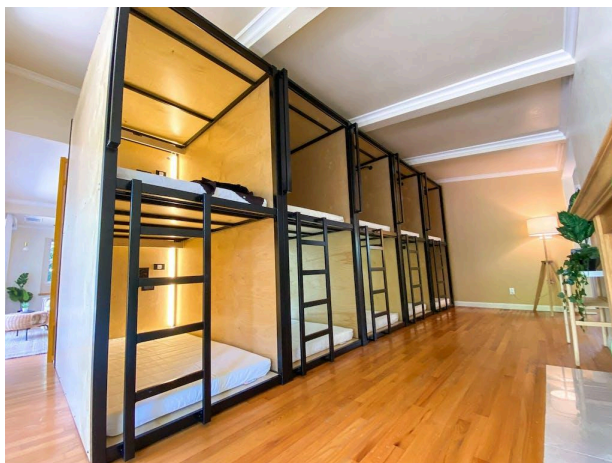

Steps to get it Done

- Acquire Land locally for project development site, and prepare it for development
- Set up the new configuration of buses and module containers
- Set up the new pavement and flooring for the common areas
- Set up the external furniture and equipment
- Complete the buses conversions

We believe authentic sustainability isn't just about energy, it encompasses everything; social, economic and environmental. We bring a creative curiosity to every project development and programs to have an interesting and positive impact on our homeless population. Refurbish Public Transit Bus/Class A Motorhomes into Shelter's and Dining Spaces for Homeless

II. Social Awareness

Provide community areas where the whole community can interact and engage with each other in group sessions

III. Innovative Housing

Provide 3 Month Intensive Program to engage and empower Homeless back into the community
