## **SUGGESTED EXECUTIVE ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Fundraising Lead
  - a. Oversees all fundraising efforts for the chapter
  - b. Sends funds raised to main HER organization; manages deposits and withdrawals
  - c. Generate new fundraising ideas; create fundraising plan for the year
  - Update fundraising efforts on the HER website and main social media platforms
- 2. Distribution Lead
  - a. Oversees all distribution efforts of the chapter
  - b. Reach out to existing clubs, organizations, and NGOs your organization has affiliations with to establish partnerships and report back to HER core team.
  - c. Coordinates service trips to HER period distribution centers with other chapter members

- d. Lead volunteered-based product testing and feedback for HER reusable and sugarcane pads
- e. Support HER's period stigma research amongst female adolescence through encourage chapter members to participate

### 3. Advocacy Lead

- a. Oversees all advocacy efforts of the chapter
- b. Writes articles related to period poverty, menstrual hygiene, and women's issues (i.e. abortions, FGM, gender equality) to post on HER's blog, social media, and partner newspaper
- c. Organize a pop-up HER Menstruation Museum to decrease period stigma and increase period literacy
