

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

The submitted articles should be relevant to the theme and sub-themes of the 11th International Conference on Indonesian Social and Political Enquiries (ICISPE)

Theme:

Bridging Governance and Ecology: Navigating Energy Policy, Environmental Protection, And Climate Governance

Sub-theme:

1. Geopolitics and Environmental Security
2. Climate Governance in Crisis
3. Green Economy
4. Environmental Risk Communication

Authorship and APC:

1. Authors are permitted to submit a maximum of **2 (two) papers**, either as the first author or as a co-author.
2. The maximum number of authors permitted per manuscript is five.
3. Authors who choose to publish in the conference proceedings or a journal will be charged an author fee.
4. Payment of the author fee can be made to the bank account provided by the ICISPE Organizing Committee.

General Requirements:

Please ensure that all authors have prepared their papers in Microsoft Word in accordance with the provided guidelines and template (available at http://bit.ly/Guideline_ICISPE2026), and convert the paper to a PDF File. The authors must follow this format to avoid issues when preparing the proceedings article.

1. Page size: European A4
2. Top margin: 4 cm; bottom margin: 2,7 cm; left and right margin: 2.5 cm.
3. Using Cambria (11 pt).
4. No page numbers, no other page headers or footers.
5. Text is single-spaced.
6. All pages are in portrait orientation.

7. Tables and image information conform to the template format.
8. The articles are between 4,000 and 5,000 words (excluding the abstract and references).
9. The paper includes the author's name(s) and affiliation(s) (Department, Institution, City, Country), use institutional email address (if any).
10. The Abstract consists of 150-250 words providing concise information about the content of the article, including the main findings and conclusions.
11. All articles must have a title, authors, and affiliations, an abstract, and keywords.
12. The acceptable similarity percentage of the article is below 20% (with no exceptions).

References:

References should follow the format provided in the article template and follow the **Cite Them Right Harvard 12th citation style**. The reference list must include at least 15 primary sources. At least 60% of the references should be journal articles, while the remaining 40% may include books, conference proceedings, and other relevant sources. The use of reference management software, such as Mendeley or Zotero, is mandatory for citation and referencing.

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Notes:

1. Please ensure that the submitted paper is in its final form, ready for publication, and has been thoroughly proofread. The authors' names will be extracted exactly as they appear in the submitted file.
2. Manuscripts involving international collaboration are highly encouraged.
3. Non-compliance with the conference theme and similarity percentage requirements may result in rejection.
