

2024 ACCTA Conference Ground Transportation Info

Uber and Lyft:

(approx \$33) to center city

Philadelphia International Airport (PHL)

Distance to Notary Hotel: 10 miles

SEPTA Rail Service

The SEPTA Rail Service goes from the Airport to Jefferson Station & is about a block and a half from the hotel. Take the airport line. Depart the train at Jefferson Station and exit the station at the 12th Street and Market Street exit. It is about a 20-25 minute ride and trains run on the hour on weekends and every 30 minutes on weekdays. The fare is approx \$8.00 and is collected on the train by the conductor. However it is cheaper if you have time to stop at a Kiosk to get a Quick Trip (single ride ticket). If you are over 65, show a driver's license and the ride is free.

As with all major cities, it is strongly advised to use extra caution or other methods of transport if arriving after dark.

If arriving to Philadelphia's 30th Street Station by Amtrak train:

You can take an Uber, Lyft, take a cab (8 minute drive), or take the Market-Frankford subway. The best bet is to take the Market-Frankford line from 30th Street to Jefferson Station (about a 10 minute ride, maybe less). Leave the building and find the entrance to the subway. There should be a kiosk for a ticket or SEPTA Key Card -Take the Market-Frankford line eastbound (towards Frankford). Depart the subway at 13th and come up to street level.

You could also take a train from 30th street - the following lines all stop at Jefferson Station (then follow directions above from Jefferson):

Fox Chase, Warminster, Lansdale/Doylestown, Manayunk/Norristown, Chestnut hill East, West Trenton. - if you choose to do this you do not need to leave the building. Ask info desk for directions to SEPTA trains.
