Uploading a Video to YouTube for Educational Purposes

Step 1: Go to [YouTube.com](#).

You may also find YouTube in the G-Suite App menu.

Step 2: Check to make sure you are logged in with your .cgc email address, by clicking on the account menu.

If you need to sign in to your school email, remember it is yourmeid@cgc.edu - that will take you to the single sign on for Maricopa (students use yourmeid@maricopa.edu)

Step 3: Click on Create a Video or Post button. Choose Upload a Video from drop down.
