Op-Ed: Recent Shooting Underscores Need for Safe At Home

Core Messaging

- Today, there are more guns in our country than people, and every one in three children lives in a home with a gun.
- Too many tragedies have resulted when guns get into the hands of children, at-risk people, and people prohibited from owning a gun.
- Studies show that unsecured firearms and lost and stolen guns are fueling incidents of suicide, unintentional shootings, mass shootings, and crime in our communities.
- We can better promote responsible gun ownership in Illinois by enhancing what it means to safely store weapons and strengthening reporting requirements for lost and stolen guns.
- Safe and secure storage practices help prevent guns from being stolen, diverted into illegal markets and used in gun crime.
- Safe At Home will prevent children and at-risk and prohibited people from accessing deadly firearms and inflicting crime and violence in our communities.
- In states with secure storage laws, unintentional shootings by children were 78% lower than in states without such laws, according to Brady United.

• Lost and stolen reporting laws reduced traced illegal gun movement by 46 percent compared to states without such a law, according to Everytown.

Data Points

The Problem:

- 54% of gun owners don't lock all their guns securely.
- Every year, 350 children under the age of 18 unintentionally shoot themselves or others.
- In three-quarters of school shootings, the shooter acquired the firearm from their parents or other relatives (U.S. Secret Service).
- An estimated 82% of adolescent firearm suicides involve a gun belonging to a family member (Johns Hopkins).
- Every year, over 380,000 firearms are stolen from their lawful owners, often diverted into illegal markets fueling gun crimes and violence.
- Guns reported lost were 3 times more likely to be used in crimes, while stolen guns were 9 times more likely to be used in crimes (UC Davis).

Impact of Secure Storage Laws:

- Unintentional shootings by children decrease 78% in states with secure storage laws (Brady United).
- Illegal guns movement down 46% in states with lost and stolen reporting laws (Everytown for Gun Safety).
- 72% of U.S. adults, including 58% of gun owners, support requiring by law that people lock up their guns in their home when not in use to prevent handling by children or teenagers without adult supervision (Johns Hopkins).
- A suicide attempt using a firearm is fatal in 90% of cases (Johns Hopkins).
- Black youth are currently experiencing three times greater firearm suicide rates than they did a decade ago, demonstrating further need to limit firearm access by children and teens (Johns Hopkins).
- Research from 2020 found that states with strong Safe Storage policies have seen an
 estimated 12% reduction in youth firearm suicides (among children ages 0–14) and a 13%
 reduction in deaths and injuries among the same population resulting from unintentional
 shootings (Johns Hopkins).
- In one study, researchers posited that between 6% and 32% of all youth firearm deaths could be prevented through the passage and implementation of strong Safe Storage laws (Johns Hopkins).
