

K-5th grade - Fine Arts (Week 8)

Objective:

- Students will participate in a variety of activities related to art and music for at least 45 minutes total.

For Students:

- Make sure that you look at the [“My Music Video”](#) file with your parents for information about this project.
- Pick a song that you like and make a short 1-2 min music video showing how the song makes you feel. For example: I chose the song *We Are Family* from the Movie *Ice Age 4: Continental Drift*. My music video shows different ways my family and I enjoy time together. We love to be silly and hangout. Even though we are all different, we still are a family.
- Others may have a different way of explaining a song. It is completely alright. BE CREATIVE & BE YOU!
- You can use TikTok, Snapchat, VivaVideo or any other apps to edit or add effects to your music video. Don’t stress if you don’t use any of the apps, add your own uniqueness to your video.
- IF you DO NOT have access to a computer or Internet, that is fine. YOU may write out your ideas of your music video. Example: What is the song you chose and who it’s by, also what would be happening in your music video. REMEMBER must be school appropriate.
- SHARE them with your teacher by email. We can’t wait to see! Have fun!
