- Treasurer – Dom’s comments after November “meeting”
  - Closed Wells Fargo account
  - Opened new accounts at Umpqua Bank, which is located in each city we operate in.
  - Left \$10k in Checking
  - Put \$15k in a 7 month CD and will continue to renew that on a 12 month basis after it matures so that it aligns close to our fiscal year. Then we will have that available if we decide we need the money on a future budget.
  - Put the remainder of our cash ~\$17k in a Money Market Account where it will earn interest and be readily available should we need it.
  - Applied for a credit card and should have that in about a week or so.
- Dominic’s concern - We will need to have a Motion to add Jeff the account so we have someone else with access, in case something happens to me.
- Dominic mentioned – Also there was talk a few months ago about getting member email addresses from the clubs to build a mailing list in mailchimp (or similar service). Do we still want to do that? If so, it would make sense to include that request in my email to the clubs about how to pay dues. We would just need to figure how we want to collect that data and where to safely store it before we load it to our vendor.

- Dom to include request for email addresses in his reminder to member clubs about paying dues. Will move forward with setting up MailChimp for email comms to full membership once we have addresses.
