## FAQ - School Saving Bonus (SSB)

- Q. What can I use my SSB towards?
  - A.- Uniform purchases (in person only using your SSB voucher code)
  - School Activities which includes:
    - Excursions
    - Incursions
    - Camps
    - Sporting Events
    - Grade 6 Graduation
      \*NOTE: Excludes whole school events of \$10 and under.
- Q. What is <u>NOT covered</u> by the SSB?
  - A Campion stationery lists
    - Prime Maths workbook
- Q. How do I see how much SSB I have allocated or have left to allocate?
  - A. Go to the <u>SSB Parent Portal</u>. Should you have funds still to allocate, we encourage you to allocate this to "School Activities". NB: You will need your SSB Voucher Number and the email address for Parent #1 to do this.
- Q. I have allocated my SSB to School Activities. Why can't I see this in Compass?
  - A. Compass is a communication portal and doesn't "hold" the SSB funds. Our Finance Manager can view and manage your SSB allocations, via our school software, and administer it to Compass events accordingly.
- Q. Will my SSB be used on all events (until used up) if I have allocated it to School Activities?

A. It will be allocated to the majority of events. However, it will NOT be allocated for whole school events of \$10 and under, due to the administrative burden involved.

Q. How will I know whether my SSB is paying for an event?

A. If you don't see a payment to be made in an event or it shows as a "\$0" then your SSB allocation is being used.

If you see an amount payable when consenting, your SSB has run out, or the event is ineligible\* for the SSB.

Q. What happens to any SSB amounts that aren't used?

A. If you do not use all of your SSB in 2025, it will transfer to 2026.

NOTE: Any balance remaining in the SSB Portal on **30**<sup>th</sup> **June 2025**, will **automatically transfer to School Activities**.
