The United States' largest, most widely recognized, and oldest civil rights organization was established on February 12, 1909. The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) is an interracial U.S. organization created to abolish segregation and discrimination in housing, education, employment, voting, and transportation. It was founded to oppose racism and ensure African Americans have their constitutional rights. After 113 years in existence, the grassroots organization currently has two million members.
