Conviction History Eligibility for AmeriCorps

Under AmeriCorps regulations, an individual is **ineligible** to work or serve on an AmeriCorps grant if they:

- Refuse to consent to the NSCHC (National Service Criminal History Checks);
- Make a false statement in connection with NSCHC (provide false name, false ID or fingerprints);
- Are registered, or are required to be registered, on a state sex offender registry or the National Sex Offender Registry; or
- Have been **convicted of murder**, as defined in 18 U.S.C. 1111.
