Who should sign up for a Shadow Day?

We invite any current 8th-10th grade prospective student who is interested in attending Orange Lutheran to join us for a Shadow Day.

May my 7th grader shadow?

Due to high demand, we reserve our Shadow Days for current 8th grade prospective students. 7th graders are welcome to join us for Fall Open House (Oct. 18), Winter Open House (Jan. 23), and Campus Tours. Prospective students in any grade are always welcome to call our Admissions Office (714-998-5151) for more information about our Admissions process.

Is shadowing mandatory for all prospective students?

Certainly not. Shadowing will give current prospective students a better picture of what a typical day at Orange Lutheran is like. It is helpful, but not a requirement for our Admissions process.

I just signed my son/daughter up for a Shadow Day. How do I know that the registration went through?

Upon hitting "submit" when you completed our online registration form, a confirmation window should have popped up, notifying you that your registration was submitted successfully. You will receive a reminder email approximately 2 days before your scheduled Shadow Day.

What are the check-in/pick-up details?

Check-in is at 8:00 am in the Upper Gymnasium (look for arrows in the parking lot). Pick-up is at 12:15 in front of the Welcome Center.

What should my son/daughter wear?

We do not wear uniforms, but stress modesty, message, and safety. Our dress code can be reviewed [HERE](#).

My student already shadowed but would like to shadow again. Is this permitted?

To allow room for other prospective students for other prospective students to shadow, we limit each student to shadowing only once. What will my student be doing all day?

Your student will be paired up with a host student from Orange Lutheran with similar interests; academic classes, extra-curricular activities, etc. Your student will attend class with his/her host, attend Daily Gathering, and join our student body for lunch.

What should my student bring? Your student need only bring themselves! A backpack is not necessary. In the event that a test or quiz is being given in a class, an iPad or book to read is sometimes helpful.

May my student bring their cell phone? Yes. We allow our students to bring and use their cell phones on campus. However, we ask that cell phones remain turned off during class periods.

My son/daughter knows someone from OLu. Can you guarantee that they will be together for Shadow Day? We love pairing prospective students up with current Orange Lutheran students they already know. However, sometimes extenuating circumstances don't allow for this to happen. We do take every request into consideration and try to be as accommodating as possible. We thank you for understanding.
