Classroom Rules/Expectations:

- 1. Respect your peers, adults, and schools
- 2. Listen and follow directions
- 3. Keep hands and feet to yourself
- 4. Stay on task and use time wisely
- 5. Stay in your designated area

Reward System/Positive Behavior Incentives:

Students will be earning Principal's Club Tickets and Classroom Coupons in our class. When a student is identified for performing a task properly or conducting an outstanding act of kindness, they will be rewarded with a Principal's Club Ticket. These tickets will be turned in schoolwide and students will have the opportunity to be rewarded with different things throughout the year. Students can also earn Classroom Coupons by passing reading and math lessons on I-Ready throughout the week. Examples of these coupons are No Homework Pass, Bring a Buddy (stuffed animal), Wear a Hat, Use V.I.P. Supplies, etc.

We will also have a Mystery Student chosen randomly every day. If the Mystery Student has maintained excellent behavior throughout the day, they will be revealed and celebrated at the end of the school day, earning a prize and a Happy Mail note home.

Consequences:

If a student fails to follow rules/expectations and MBE Guidelines for Success, they will be given a Consequence Ticket. The ticket will be hole-punched one time for a warning, a second time for a parent text or call, and a third time for a silent lunch or detention (depending on the behavior). If behavior continues, additional parent conferences may be needed, which will include teacher, student, and parent.

Homework Expectations:

- Each student will have a Take-Home Binder. The Take-Home Binder should be brought back and forth between home and school each day.
- A newsletter will be sent home on Mondays containing phonics/spelling words, skills being taught in class, and important information for the week.

All homework will be located on and attached to the weekly newsletter.

- **Phonics/Spelling homework** will be due on Fridays. Students will have four spelling activities attached to the newsletter to be completed for the week. Our spelling words are important because they reinforce phonics skills!
- Math homework will be due on Fridays. Students will have a math skills handout to complete that will review topics being covered for the week or previous topics. This homework should not take more than 10 minutes a night, if worked on every night, Monday through Thursday. Please text or email me if you have any questions about math homework. I am here to help!
- Each student will be expected to **read 20 minutes every night**. This may include but is not limited to: AR books, magazines/articles, appropriate internet articles/material... anything, really! Reading should be FUN!:)
- Students will be allowed to work on homework during the last 15 minutes of the school day.

Tuesday Folders:

- Every Tuesday your child will be taking home a graded work folder. This
 folder will contain all graded assignments from the previous week.
- Please review your child's graded work with him/her and sign the inside of the folder next to the proper date. This lets the teacher know that parents/guardians have checked their child's graded work from the previous week.
- Some graded assignments will be completed online. Please ask your child about assignments/tests/assessments completed on Google Classroom or SchoolNet. They will know how to log in and show you their work, along with the grade. Login information can be found in your child's Take-Home Binder.

Snacks:

- Every day our class will have a snack period some time between 9:00am and 9:30am. The exact time will depend on when instruction can be paused.
- Students are expected to clean up after themselves; no food or drink should be left on the floor, on desks, or inside of desks. If this becomes a continuous problem, parents will be contacted.
- Please make sure that your child brings a snack if he or she would like to participate in snack each day. Please do not bring snacks to the office to be delivered to the child.
 This can interrupt instructional time. We promise they will not go hungry at school!
- Snacks will not be provided for students.
