

Please use these resources to "crash" Spring 2020 Global Studies class due to the shift to an online class format.

If there are **discussion sections** associated with this class, please have **3 different section choices** that would work with your schedule ready to indicate to make it easier to give you an approval code if one becomes available.

A few notes about these forms:

- You will need to be logged in to your **UCSB Google account** to submit these request forms - the survey will collect your email address and this will be the address we'll reach out to you at if we have a space in the course for you. If you "don't have access" to the survey, make sure you're logged in correctly on your device to your UCSB Google account, not a personal account.
- The shift towards an online class system with short notice and during a generally stressful time will mean that we **can't make any guarantees** about your chances of getting into this course or about the timing of when you'll hear back.
 - We **hope** tentatively to have students enrolled before the start of the quarter, but at this time cannot make any guarantees on timing.
 - If you send emails asking about your status** on the list, they may not be answered as we are working hard to get everything moved online for spring.
- These requests will **NOT be first-come, first-served** but instead will be **prioritized by genuine need** for the course (and the undergraduate advisor will be verifying these requests as a "need" versus a "want").
 - Please be ready to be **flexible** with the courses you're already enrolled in if you're not a senior who 100% needs to take the course this quarter and has generally been completing classes at a sensible rate (eg., you didn't change your major late into your junior or senior year) OR a person whose spring schedule was affected by a study abroad program cancellation.
- Please do NOT use these forms to request a **different section** for the class in which you're already enrolled - that request form will come at a future time.

NOTES:

- **Asynchronous** = course will typically not require you to log in at the specific, scheduled time frame and work can be completed on your own schedule throughout the week

- **Synchronous** = course will have at least some elements requiring you to log in and attend a lecture during the scheduled time frame (contact the professor for what to do if you'll be in a different time zone/unavailable during the scheduled "class time" - videos of lectures, etc., may still be posted on Gauchospace for future watching on your own, but check with the instructor)
