Remote Learning Option for Semester #2

Commit to IN-PERSON LEARNING

- ❑ Students who are currently in-person learners do not need to do anything in particular if they plan to remain within this mode of instruction. Mr. Caldwell will have semester two course schedules available upon request within the coming weeks. We currently have 85% of all learners in person, and we do anticipate a rise in this percentage for the second semester.
- ❑ Students who are currently remote learning, but who wish to come back to in-person learning will need to **complete a commitment form**. This must be signed by a parent or a legal guardian. We will build your course schedule after receiving that necessary paperwork.

Commit to REMOTE LEARNING

- ❑ Any student wishing to pursue remote learning for the second semester will be required to **complete a commitment form** here at Shelbyville High School. This must be signed by a parent or a legal guardian. As a reminder, students who opt for remote learning are not allowed to return to in-person instruction.
