- The Defur’ii Isles is located near the equator, and it is separated from southern Europe. As the island went near the equator, the island became categorized as a rocky island with several waterways and rainforests, due to the humid and hot climate of the equator. The coasts of the island are very rocky, there are several tall cliffs- still, the island has golden, sandy beaches, which makes for a beautiful sunset view. Across the coast, there are several caves and underground systems, which can be very dangerous to navigate

because they are very unstable and can cave in. Further in the island, the rocky outer edges slowly transition into lush rainforests, surrounded by mountains and rivers. The Defur'ii Isles has one main island, but also has small island fragments surrounding it. The further islands are more sandy and rocky than the interior, and are also more dry. The two main mountain ranges in the Defur'ii Isles are the Hau-Maumoto and Bas-Maumoto mountains, which in turn create the Maumoto Mountains region. These mountains are filled with verdant greenery, and can go up to heights of 2000 m. Other regions of the Defur'ii Isles include the Nordhunt Islands, the Sudkatch Islands, and Nugget Island. Nordhunt is more rocky, contains more flat lands and plains, and has the most cave systems in the isles. Sudkatch Islands are categorized as having much more waterways, and there are several rainforests in the area. Nugget Island is the island that is furthest from the main island, and the sand on the island is an unusual gold hue, hence the name "Nugget Island".

- Overall, the Defur'ii Isles is more or less a tropical island, but different regions of the island have their own unique geographical environment, which in turn promotes the cultural and societal differences between the auteryx.

Climate

- Because the Defur'ii Isles are very close to the equator, the climate is very humid and hot, The islands are constantly underneath a blanket of warm mist, even on a sunny day, and it has a tropical, vacation-like atmosphere. The waters surrounding the island are still cooler, but still quite warm. This makes cooling off an almost impossible task, as even the shade of trees cannot fully compensate for the blazing heat.
- In terms of weather, the Defur'ii Isles are often very sunny. There is still the occasional rainfall though, and everytime there is rainfall, it is often very heavy or a light shower- there is no inbetween! Like many places near the equator, the isles have two main seasons: The dry season and the monsoon season. During the dry season, it gets very hot and water is very rare, so most of the auteryx like to hide out in caves, or spend a lot of time in the ocean water to stay safe. However, during the monsoon season, the water levels get very high, so it is safer for the auteryx to move further inland so that they do not get swept out into the ocean. During this season, the auteryx will hunt freshwater fish in the land's various lakes and rivers.

- The Auteryx species have a pretty big island to live on, so it is obvious that they will live in several different areas. As of now, there are six main Auteryx settlements: Seusol, Troulak, Gehpolle, Reincov, Daebys Deep, and Nuggetport!
- Seusol is a settlement of Auteryx who are located in a somewhat isolated island in the Nordhunt Island region. The Auteryx who live there are categorized to be quite defensive and closed off at first, but they will also protect their friends/loved ones with their life. The settlement is very simple, with Auteryx making their homes in caverns, and only going out into the Risico Sea to hunt for food. There are not much places for Seusol Auteryx to socialize, and the temperatures are much colder there which makes them spend the most of their time in the caverns. In their free time, Seusol Auteryx enjoy drawing on the cavern walls, and telling stories to the juvenile Auteryx!
- Troulak is an Auteryx settlement that is located near a large lake. The climate there is very humid and tropical, so a lot of Auteryx choose to live there- in fact, it is one of the most populated settlements! The Auteryx there like to weave small huts out of the long grass that grows there to build places to live, and juvenile Auteryx train in the lake to hone their fishing skills. Since Troulak is pretty far away from the oceans, the majority of the Troulak Auteryx like to only hunt freshwater fish. Still, there are some Troulak Auteryx who will dare themselves to hunt in the dangerous oceans, to prove themselves to their friends and family. The Auteryx who live in Troulak can be best categorized as friendly, warm, yet also mischievous!
- Gehpolle is a sandy, beach area and it is renowned for its beautiful sunsets. Gehpolle is considered to be a "trading port" for all Auteryx, and it does not have a lot of permanent residents. There are lots of small caverns in which Auteryx can set up and sell their wares! Some Auteryx who really want to sell their wares can have permanent housing there, which lets them sell a lot of stuff. The Auteryx who visit and reside in Gehpolle are very unique and diverse since they come from all parts of the Defur'ii Isles!
- Reincov is unique for being very far from any major bodies of water. The Auteryx who live there hunt freshwater fish in the streams and small rivers that run throughout their territory. Reincov is situated in the middle of a massive rainforest, so the Auteryx dig burrows and live in there- sometimes, the burrows can get so big that entire generations of Auteryx can live in one burrow! Since fish is somewhat rare, Reincov Auteryx often have to resort to hunting creatures on land, such as paddlerats, bugs, and other small animals. Reincov Auteryx are considered to be very resourceful, yet often very strange, as their customs are drastically different from several different Auteryx settlements.
- Daebys Deep is a small tribe of Auteryx that is located in the south of the Defur'ii Isles, and is very dangerous as it is surrounded by the shark-infested Casroial and Requitan Oceans. The Auteryx who live there are thought of as brave yet mysterious, as they often do not share their ways of life with outsiders. Daebys Auteryx are also one of the strongest out of all Auteryx, as they hunt sharks as their main form of food, alongside smaller fish. They like to make clothing and accessories out of shark teeth- the more shark teeth an Daebys Auteryx has on their apparel, the more braver they seem! Still, it is unknown how the hunters can take down scary sharks, and their hunting techniques are only known by the hunters of the settlement.

- Nuggetport is the furthest settlement from the central Defur'ii Isles island. It does not have any permanent residents, because the seas around it are strangely devoid of any fish. The only reason why Auteryx visit Nuggetport is to serve as a form of "camping", where they can get away from life and enjoy themselves for a few days. Nuggetport is also the home to the very rare Gold Nugget, a valued currency amongst Auteryx. Gold Nuggets can be found on the vibrant golden beaches of Nuggetport. Nuggetport has some small wooden and stone structures, likely left there by other Auteryx who visited the island in the past, which can serve as shelter.
- The central islands of the Defur'ii Isles (Troulak, Gehpolle, Reincov) are considered as the central three settlements since most Auteryx choose to settle there. The collective name for this group is known as the "Centrum" group of Auteryx settlements.
- Seusol and the Daebys Deep are not geographically very close, but are considered as "Porro " group, since they are more peripheral in nature.

Oceans

- The Requitian Ocean ("The Shark Ocean") is an ocean located near the south-west of the Defur'ii Isles. It is a very deep and dangerous ocean that is infested with several violent species, such as hostile sharks, barracuda, and georgiacetus. It is not recommended for Auteryx to go into these waters, unless they want to get wounded or eaten. The Daebys Deep is located near this ocean, and the settlement's hunters are the only ones who know how to hunt effectively.
- The Risico Ocean ("The Risk Ocean ") is an ocean located near the north-west of Defur'ii Isles. It is a very risky ocean to be in, hence its name. Usually, the sea is very shallow, but there are poorly-filled in trenches, which means that an unsuspecting Auteryx can get swallowed up by the sand if they are not careful. Furthermore, the tides are very strong, and the water level increases and decreases drastically. Risico Ocean is the main hunting grounds for the Seusol Auteryx, and there are a plethora of decent sized fish there, which is enough to make it a nice ocean to fish in.
- The Casorial Ocean is arguably the safest ocean which surrounds the Defur'ii Isles. The Ocean has a beautiful marine landscape, with underwater hoodoos (strange natural rock formations) and abysses. The marine life there is very calm as well, as there are many variety of fish and other marine life. The Casroial Ocean also is home to sharks and georgiacetus, but they are rarely hostile towards Fisher Auteryx because there is a plethora of fish for them to eat. These waters are used by the Daebys and occasionally the Reincov Auteryx.

- Alongside the Auteryx are several other species that inhabit the Defur'ii Isles- these creatures exist in both the land and the water!
- As Auteryx primarily hunt in the waters, there are lots of creatures that also co-inhabit these waters in search of food and habitats. The majority of these are fish; there are some that resemble those in the actual world, and even those that are extinct in reality, but have persisted in the world of Auteryx - an example of which being georgiacetus . Furthermore, other species have completely adapted to the isolated tropical environment, gaining several traits to survive efficiently in the Defur'ii Isle's marine environment and developing into completely original species. These unique species include:
 - Silver Fish (Marinitidus argentus)
 Marinitidus argentus, more commonly known to Auteryx as "silver fish" are a staple in the diet of any auteryx. These small, silver fish with large protruding eyes mainly flock in schools, decorating the azure waters of the oceans with their shining forms. As Silver Fish have lots of natural predators, one natural adaptation that they have extremely lustrous scales. When they are in danger, Silver fish angle themselves in the right direction to momentarily blind a predator with their shiny scales so that they can escape.
 To cope with this annoying trait, Auteryx only typically hunt silver fish during rainy/cloudy days, when there is a minimized amount of sunlight- this makes it less likely for the fish to escape through using their special ability.
 Silver fish are a very nutritious species, they are exceptionally high in OMEGA-3 oils, protein, fat- which makes it so that Auteryx mainly depend on them to nourish themselves! Since silver fish are so nutritious, Auteryx often use them as a form of currency, offering silver fish for goods and services.
 - Twiggills (vimenbranch arenicolus)
 vimenbranch arenicolus, or Twigfish, are an exceptionally ugly type of marine creature that lives in the shallows of the Defur'ii Isles. To prevent being eaten, these fish have adapted to look a bit like small twigs and driftwood, and bury themselves in the sand, hiding from predators while at the same time disguising themselves to secretly catch small prey.
 To Auteryx, Twiggills do not provide much nutritional/food value since they are so small, and have very spiky bones. The only Twiggills that are edible are found in Seusol, as these Twiggills are much larger than other subspecies and there is value to hunt them. Young Auteryx like to dig up the sand to find these small fish, and chuck them back into the water. What is very surprising about twiggills is a form of convergent evolution; they have some capacity to breathe on land for a few minutes, similar to mudskippers. This may perhaps indicate that in the future, this miserable-looking species may somehow join the Auteryx on land.
 - Pumipents (miniserpens pumex)

Miniserpens pumex, despite having a name that would imply it to be a species of snake, is actually a semiaquatic eel species that have evolved to live in the holes in the pumice that make up the rocky coasts of the Defur'ii Isles. As this pumice is both located in and near water, these eels have developed the capacity to remain on land, as long as they are not over-exerted. Having a very acidic coating used to their advantage, Pumipents can deepen and remain in the dark holes of pumice, and often sneak attack on small bugs and fish that approach near them. Most auteryx choose to not hunt these Pumipents, as it is very hard to pry them out of the pumice - it would be more worthwhile to hunt other foods. However, an exception is the Gepolle Auteryx - as the area is very rocky due to the great beaches, there is an exceeding overabundance of pumipents that incite Auteryx to use them as a food source.

- The major land-dwelling species in the Defur'ii Isles are the rattus paxicauda, or paddlerats. Paddlerats are a species of rodent which have adapted to a mostly-marine habitat, with massive, heavy tails that allow for strong propelling in the water, as well as webbed paws. They are mostly considered as a pest, but certain auteryx, especially young ones, keep them as pets! It is arguable if paddlerats have capacity for higher thought like Auteryx, but it is a rule to always respect paddlerats as sentient beings, even if one may think of them as a nuisance.

Beyond the Isles

- The Defur'ii Isles has been moved so far from the mainland that no communication is possible (with current Auterian technology) with other landmasses and species. One can only imagine what the rest of the world looks like!
- However, since there has been no indication of the Chicxulub meteor incident, it is possible to infer that the descendants of dinosaurs live on.. But this is all just conjecture.

Auteryx Culture

- Auteryx are a very intelligent species, on the par with crows and dolphins in the actual world. They have a language, are emotionally intelligent, and demonstrate sentience - they can also utilize tools/create weapons, and even have the capacity to manipulate natural phenomena, such as starting fires and creating dams to manage water flow, etc. However, when judging Auterian society, it is evidently simpler than human society, so on the Kardashev scale, Auteryx would be rated around a 0.19 (low score :().

- Auteryx speak the language “Auterian”, The spoken version sounds like a bunch of click-like noises and has a limited amount of words, similar to the language “Toki pona”. This form of language, although quite rudimentary upon a first glance, has a similar level of complexity as dolphin language, and allows Auteryx to convey meaning, thought, and feelings into how they express themselves through language. This language also has unwritable aspects, making the entirety of written Auterian unable to encapsulate the true essence of spoken Auterian- this may have been due to the fact that written Auterian was established relatively recently compared to spoken Auterian.
- There are two different types of Auterian alphabets: Old Auterian and New Auterian. Old Auterian is the earliest forms of written language made by Auteryx, and only has a few symbols for sounds to write out names, and commonly-known terms such as fish, tree, sky, water, etc. This written language was mostly used either to keep records of trades, or to record extremely important events; it mainly held a purely functional purpose. However, as Auteryx evolved and gained higher cognitive functions, there was a necessity for a more complex language. This led to the development of New Auterian, a more complex written language that added more sounds and vocabulary to the initial Old Auterian. What is very fascinating about New Auterian is that Old Auterian can still be easily distinguished within the language, with almost no evolution of Old Auterian into completely New Auterian language. The alphabet of both New and Old Auterian is a mix of logograms and alphabet based language, although in Old Auterian there is an emphasis on more symbols, while the newer counterpart focuses more on letters to create words.
- However, for comprehension reasons in the real world, there is an english-equivalent Auterian alphabet that allows English to be translated into Auteryx script. This includes symbols that are in the Auterian alphabet, while other letters in the English alphabet that do not exist in Auterian have special Auterian counterparts just for this purpose.
- As Auteryx cannot really communicate in water, they have a sign language equivalent of Auterian as well. There are only a limited number of words in this sign language, as most of them are centered around hunting - these include actions for words such as fish, danger, shark, left, right, etc. Auterian sign language is typically communicated through movements of the whole body rather than using solely the limbs, as the watery environment in which this language developed permits for whole body movements, and the limbs are typically needed by auteryx to hold spears and hunt, making them resort to using the entire body to indicate meaning.

- Auteryx all have their own unique traditions depending on each local settlement. They are all very separated due to the unique topology of the land, making it difficult for them to have wholly unified traditions. However, there are a few common traditions amongst all Auteryx, although several areas have taken their own spin on them and changed them greatly. These include:

- Fish Hunt Traditions

- After hunting fish, Auteryx usually perform a sort of rite- this is to thank the fish for giving its life up for food, as well as thanking their fellow Auteryx for a successful hunt. The standard procedure for this tradition is to verbally thank the fish for sacrificing their lives, sharing one fish amongst the hunters, then allowing the most productive fisher to claim the biggest fish for themselves. Some Auteryx communities have added more steps to this process, such as swimming back to the hunting grounds to return the remains of the fish and drinking seawater alongside eating the fish. Nevertheless, even though all Auteryx might have a different way for having a post-fishing tradition, it always involves thanking the fish and fellow hunters - this is crucial in Auterian society, where respect for all living beings is crucial and encouraged.

- First Hunt

- For Auteryx training to be hunters, a first hunt is a test that they must pass to become a fully-fledged hunter. Of course, hunters do not necessarily need to take this test as they can just freely hunt to provide for themselves, but successfully finishing the “first hunt” is a great achievement that shows off the fishing prowess of the Auteryx- making it an extremely desirable thing that many aspiring hunters want to take part in. This tradition basically involves a hunter trainee going on a solo hunt and collecting different fish species - traditionally, a hunter would have to successfully procure 10 silver fish, a large deep sea fish, and a fish of their choice to pass. However, what makes this challenge especially difficult is that this hunter must go by themselves to hunt - which can be quite dangerous in the various oceans of the Defur’ii Isles. As many Auteryx have lost their lives partaking in this tradition, many areas are planning to ban this practice. However, certain groups, like the risk-taking Daebys Deep and Seusol Auteryx, still find value within this tradition, and almost all the hunter auteryx from these areas try and undertake the First Hunt.

- Daily customs

- On a daily basis, Auteryx have a set of societal values that they often follow. Similar to human society, values such as honesty, kindness, and respect, are prominent in Auterian society, and are expected to be demonstrated every day, even more prominently than human society. However, “corrupt values”, such as violence, aggression, distrust, etc. are more looked down upon than in typical society, and the consequences for horrible actions are more severe- if committing a crime or an action that violates the peace within the Isles, Auteryx can face a

variety of saddening consequences; they are often ostracized and exiled from their settlement, being forced to live on their own as a result of their actions.

- Mallantang (Dry Season Festival)
 - Mallantang occurs during the peak months of the dry season (March to September), which is around June to July. Mallantang is typically celebrated by preparing fish jerky/smoked fish, as well as taking time to rest from the blazing summer heat. This results in the preparation of grand festivals and also vacations for Auteryx. These festivals include the week-long Shyomul celebration, in which Auteryx will partake in several activities including dancing, singing, and even synchronized swimming to gain fish jerky and local recognition. Furthermore, a key component of these festivals are lighting bonfires at night and roasting fish, all of which is a very fun part of Auteryx culture. These celebrations signify a recognition of an Auteryx's work, and also provide a well deserved rest. In terms of vacations that are taken during Mallantang, these include traveling to other areas in the Defur'ii Isles to meet up with faraway relatives and friends, or going to Nugget Island to go camping.
- Vienmul (Wet Season Festival)
 - Vienmul is yet another important festival that is celebrated in Auterian culture, during the wet season (October - February). Due to the fact that fishes are more plentiful during the wet season, and there is less sun (due to the rain) that makes it easier to hunt, Vienmul is celebrated in association with fish and hunting- these include mass hunts, fishing challenges, and overall feats of strength that showcase and recognize the fishers of Auterian society.
- Jewelry
 - Most auteryx wear a special jewel pendant around the necks. These necklaces are given to auteryx when they transition from youth to adulthood as a gift from their family. After hatching, an auteryx's parents will find a special rock, and prepare the special necklace for the touching, important pendant-giving ceremony. The necklace is not mandatory, but if an auteryx does not have one, it is implied that they had absent or uncaring parents. If an auteryx loses their special necklace, it is like losing a part of their bond with family.

Foods

- Auteryx are omnivores, basically eating just about anything that is available to them. In the small Defur'ii Isles, this is a critical trait to have, because in bad seasons food can become limited; Auteryx will have to resort to eating all sorts of things that they can find.
- The most common type of food that Auteryx eat are fish. The primary fish that makes up this diet includes the Silver Fish, as it is the most abundant in the Defur'ii Isles' waters and has a high nutritional content. Some other miscellaneous, localized fish make up the rest of the Auteryx's fish consumption, but this varies depending on the settlement since each part of the Defur'ii Isles has a vastly different topographical structure, affecting what foods can be hunted in these areas. The most notable of these local fish species include

mega-twigfish in Seusol, Pumipents in Gehpolle, and even juvenile sharks that are hunted by the Daebys Deep Auteryx.

- Auteryx have a variety of professions that they can partake in, although specialized jobs are somewhat rare, and the majority of Auteryx choose one main job or another. Ultimately, it is up to the Auteryx's owner to decide how to develop the profession of their Auteryx- as it is their character, they hold the ultimate creative decision, but these are merely lore-accurate suggestions as to what an Auteryx can do!
- An important profession that exists in Auterian society is the fisher. These fishers are the main food providers in Auteryx society, as they are the ones that go out and procure fish to eat, which comprises the majority of an Auteryx's diet. This is also a very dangerous profession, as the waters in which the Auteryx hunt are infested with dangerous creatures and phenomenons - sharks, sharp rocks, and rogue waves, to name a few. Many Auteryx have been wounded or killed in this position, making it one of the deadliest in Auterian society. However, due to these dangers, the position of a fisher is one that is greatly celebrated and appreciated, and exceptional hunters are widely considered as an integral part of Auteryx society - hence still, even though the position is very dangerous, it attracts Auteryx who want to become renowned and contribute to their community.
- Traders are also a very important part of facilitating the exchange of resources across the Defur'ii Isles. These traders often procure several local specialties, and travel around the Isles in search of getting profit by selling these items. Traders often live a nomadic lifestyle, but they often have a main "area" in which they get local items from, which is often their hometown.
- The carver is also a very common profession in Auteryx culture. These carvers make a living selling stone totems and carvings, both of which have aesthetic and cultural value to Auteryx. The most renowned carvers are ones that make totems that are very detailed, and are believed to bring the most good fortune to Auteryx. For any creative and artistic auteryx, this is a perfect profession for them!

Beliefs

- Auteryx believe that rocks/stones hold great power. This is because when Auteryx eggs are close to the presence of stone totems, they typically tend to have a higher chance of gaining lots of rare traits, such as multiple limbs and even the ability to manipulate the environment in ways never seen before. This has led to Auteryx making nests for their eggs encircled in stone, hoping that the rocks will grant their children amazing abilities. Furthermore, stones, and different minerals in general, play an important part in defining

an Auteryx's identity through a pendant (discussed in more detail in the jewelry section of [Customs/Traditions/Values](#)). As a way to honor the stones, Auteryx often find carving to be something important, and many Auteryx carve stone totems to wish prosperity and luck for themselves and their loved ones. However, Auteryx are not wholly dependent on these stones as an explanation for everything that occurs in their life - although recognizing their importance in their culture, Auteryx wholly believe that everything that happens to them occurs due to natural phenomena, and the stones only play a small part in it.

Auteryx Life

Lifespan

- Auteryx have a decently long natural lifespan, living for 25-30 years if they make it to old age. However, as Auteryx often frequent dangerous waters to hunt for food, this can result in injuries that greatly reduce lifespan, or even cause premature death. This makes it so the average Auteryx has a lifespan of 10-15 years, as they are likely very injured or weakened by the constant exposure to this difficult marine lifestyle. However, older auteryx are not unheard of, and the life expectancy of Auteryx is slowly growing as Auteryx continue to develop new technologies to protect Auteryx during their time in the water.

- Auteryx evolved from the archaeopteryx, a prehistoric bird-like dinosaur species. A select number of these birds ended up being stuck on a part of a peninsula that broke off, and ended up drifting away, isolating these dinosauroids to independently evolve from the mainland. As they were encircled by water, the proto-auteryx evolved mechanisms to effectively live in the water, such as sleek feathers to swim efficiently, high amounts of blubber, and a special type of nose and oxygen retention skills that allowed them to become fearsome underwater hunters. Furthermore, as this exclusively marine environment became dangerous with the presence of rival species, proto-auteryx evolved several different types of communal and cultural intelligence, living and thriving with one another to help survive in this new environment.
- Eventually, the proto-auteryx evolved to an extent that it became a completely different species from the initial archaeopteryx- the celeaquavis auteryx, or commonly known as "Auteryx"!

- Due to the somewhat different biomes that are found in different parts of the Defur'ii Isles, there are minor adaptations that Auteryx have gained to adapt. These adaptations, although minimal, have allowed for the development of subspecies. Auteryx that live in Seulsol can be considered a subspecies known as "Coastal Auteryx" - they have thicker feathers, more blubber, and have a more "rugged" form, allowing them to hunt effectively in the more rocky and cold environment. Freshwater auteryx, which hunt in freshwater areas, are most commonly found in areas like Gehpolle, Troulak, and Reincov. These auteryx are more slender and sleek, with a thin frame and narrow feathers. These traits allow them to hunt efficiently in streams and lakes, all of which provide food for these areas. One of the most elusive subspecies is the Deep Sea auteryx, which comprises the most of the Daebys Deep population. These auteryx have more upper body strength and are also one of the largest subspecies, which make it very effective when hunting sharks.
- Despite having all these subspecies, most auteryx do not consider them to be important as the differences are so miniscule in the grand scheme of things!
