

Historical and Pilgrimage Tour for Muslims

Tour program:

Day 1:

Arrival at Ben Gurion Airport (Tel Aviv) by flight _____. The tour guide meets the group at the airport. A walk through the ancient streets of Jaffa – the "Bride of the Sea," an old seaport located on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. Visit to the old city and Hassan Bek Mosque. Transfer to Jerusalem, check-in at the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 2:

Breakfast. Introduction to the holy Islamic sites around the Dome of the Rock. Prayer (Salah) at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Visit to the Mount of Olives, where pilgrims can enjoy a breathtaking view of Old Jerusalem, Al-Aqsa Mosque, and the Blessed Rock Dome. Visit to the site of Prophet Isa's (Jesus') ascension (paid entry, but free for Muslims) and a panoramic view of Haram al-Sharif.

Visit to Salman Al-Farsi Mosque, located at the top of the Mount of Olives, as well as the tomb of Rabi'a al-Adawiyya. Visit to the cave where Bibi Maryam (Mary) is believed to have disappeared forever.

Gethsemane Garden – the site of Prophet Isa's attempted arrest. Visit to the birthplace of Bibi Maryam.

Visit to the burial cave of Prophet Zakariya, the tomb of Prophet Dawud (David), the site of Prophet Isa's last supper with his disciples, and the place where his mother, Bibi Maryam, is believed to have fallen into eternal rest. Optional prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Day 3:

Breakfast. Visit to the Temple Mount (Haram al-Sharif) and the Mosque of Omar (Al-Masjid Qubbat As-Sakhrah), the site where the righteous Caliph prayed after the arrival of Muslims in the Holy City.

The tour continues with a visit to Al-Buraq Wall and the Old City, surrounded by ancient walls. Visit to the Mosque of Caliph Umar ibn Al-Khattab and Nabi Samuel. Prayer either at Al-Aqsa Mosque (which is logical) or at Nabi Samuel.

Day 4:

Breakfast. Visit to the city of Al-Khalil (Hebron). Pilgrimage to the tombs of the prophets: Ibrahim and his wife Sarah, Prophet Ishaq and his wife Rifqa, Prophet Yusuf and his wife Liqya, and Prophet Yaqub and his wife Ilya. Prayer at the Ibrahimi Mosque.

Performing the combined prayers of Dhuhr and Asr.

Visit to workshops specializing in Palestinian ceramic and glass craftsmanship in Al-Khalil.

Visit to Bayt Lahm (Bethlehem) – the birthplace of Prophets Isa (Jesus) and Dawud (David). Visit to the Mosque of Caliph Umar ibn Al-Khattab, the oldest mosque in Bethlehem. Prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Day 5:

Breakfast. Visit to the city of Ramla, the former capital of the caliphate under Harun al-Rashid. The city was built by Caliph Sulayman ibn Abd al-Malik of the Umayyad dynasty, who made it his capital in 715 CE.

Visit the Great Mosque of Ramla and pray there (Dhuhr prayer).

Visit to the "Mosque of the Forty", built in memory of Muslim martyrs who died for their faith.

Visit to the underground "Pool of Arches", reminiscent of the magical tales of *One Thousand and One Nights*.

Pilgrimage to the tomb of Prophet Salih. Optional evening prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Day 6:

Breakfast. Journey to the Dead Sea – the lake of Prophet Lut (Lot).

Prayer at the tomb of Prophet Musa (Moses).

Visit to the city of Ariha (Jericho), the oldest city in the world, dating back 10,000 years.

Visit to the Umayyad Palace, built by Caliph Hisham ibn Abd al-Malik.

Swimming in the healing waters of the Dead Sea.

Return to Jerusalem. Optional evening prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Day 7:

Breakfast. Departure to Haifa – Akko.

Haifa

- **Panoramic view of the city from the top of Mount Carmel.**
- **Visit to the Bahá'í Gardens, terraced along the slopes of the mountain.**

Akko (Acre)

- **An ancient city built on the ruins of the Crusader capital, later reconstructed by the great ruler of the north, El-Jazzar.**
- **Visit to the Ahmad Al-Jazzar Mosque, which houses a sacred relic – a hair from the beard of the Prophet Muhammad.**
- **Dhuhr prayer at Al-Jazar Mosque.**
- **Akko is rich in historical landmarks, including:**
 - **Crusader halls, which were completely buried during the construction of the Muslim city.**
 - **Muslim fortress walls, which successfully repelled Napoleon's attack.**
 - **Ancient markets, caravanserais, mosques, and minarets.**

Optional evening prayer at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Day 8:

Breakfast. You can perform morning prayer on your own in Al Aqsa.
