*On 3 March, 2025, the Treasury Department announced that will it not enforce any penalties or fines associated with the beneficial ownership information reporting rule under the existing regulatory deadlines, and further it will not enforce any penalties or fines against U.S. citizens or domestic reporting companies or their beneficial owners after the forthcoming rule changes take effect either. <https://home.treasury.gov/news/press-releases/sb0038> Furthermore, a proposed new rule will limit the scope to foreign reporting companies only. Rulemaking typically takes time to allow for public comment, so the final rule will not be issued any time soon. .

- In view of the fact that there are still active court cases involving BOI reporting, this announcement may not be the final word on this issue. The entire issue could potentially reach the Supreme Court. But for now, it appears that reporting BOI information is not required. Stay tuned.
