What is a HyperDoc?

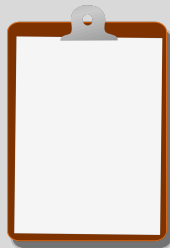


A HyperDoc is an interactive document or presentation that immerses the students in an interactive learning experience.

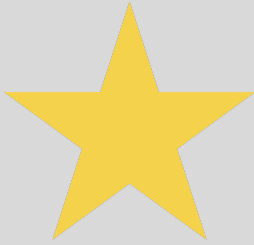
