

## Homenet Image Uploading Guidelines

### General Overview

These guidelines are provided to assist you in uploading photos with the utmost ease. You can choose to upload photos in a number of different ways. These include:

- Individual File Upload **NOT** assigned to a particular car. (See Naming Convention)
- Individual File Upload assigned to a particular car.
- Bulk photos contained in a zip file **NOT** assigned to a particular car. (See Naming Convention)
- Bulk photos contained in a zip file assigned to a particular car.

### Image Naming Convention

If you choose not to upload photos to a particular vehicle, you will need to adhere to the following naming convention. This naming convention is required so that photos will be assigned to the appropriate vehicle when they are uploaded. Failure to follow this naming convention will result in photos being uploaded to the staging area. If your photos are named incorrectly and mistakenly uploaded to the staging area you will need to contact Customer Support.

Please do not include sub folders within a zip file as the photos may not process correctly.

#### Main Image

stock-number.jpg

#### Second Image

stock-number(2).jpg

#### Subsequent Images

stock-number(next-image-number).jpg

### Example:

If you have 6 images to upload for a vehicle with a stock number of **A2234G7** then you would name your images the following way:

#### Main Image

A2234G7.jpg

#### Subsequent Images

A2234G7(2).jpg, A2234G7(3).jpg, A2234G7(4).jpg...

Please remember that you only need to name your photos by the above naming convention if you choose to upload images not associated with an existing vehicle.

### Image Specifications

<b>Maximum Upload Size:</b>	20 MB (this is the sum of all the images uploaded)
<b>Maximum Number of Photos:</b>	Unlimited*

<b>Recommended Photo Size:</b>	20-60 KB
<b>Maximum Photo Size:</b>	500 KB**
<b>Recommended Photo Dimensions:</b>	1600 x 1200***
<b>Recommended Aspect Ratio:</b>	4:3***
<b>Image format</b>	JPEG format only.

Most third parties have a maximum number of photos that they accept. You may also incur extra charges from these third-party websites. If a Third-Party Website only accepts a single image, the image you have set as the "Main Image" for a vehicle will be sent.

\*\*

Photos will be accepted that are above 100 Kilobytes. However, images above 100K will automatically be resized to the correct size. This can cause loss of quality. Increased image sizes can increase the wait time a web customer can experience when viewing a vehicle.

\*\*\*

Some third parties require that photos adhere to a 4:3 aspect ratio with a standard size of 640 x 480.
