~Question of the Day~

Each day two or three students post deep philosophical questions which relate to life, what is currently being studied or what is happening in the world.

Each question is read by the Question of the Day coordinator during Daily Announcements. Coordinator is paid 5 points per day for posting student questions and keeping the doc in tip top shape. The purpose is to make students in class think deeply towards the end of Daily Announcements. Once all questions are read, then coordinator calls for a vote by show of hands for each question. Then coordinator announces the winner. Each question posted gets up to 5 points (decided by coordinator/DOD/ King P or citizens) and another 5 points goes to the winner.

Last year, it was usually the same set of 4-6 students who would post questions. DOD can assign people to post or they can volunteer. Anyone who wants to post questions must send their questions to the Question of the Day Coordinator (or Asst and /or DOD).
