SDUHSD COURSE SELECTION GUIDELINES:

- Give careful consideration to the selections that you make now as these choices will determine your 2026-2027 schedule. Review the [Course Profiles](#) to make thoughtful, informed choices.
- Students whose Home School is an Academy (CCA or SDA) must select between 3-4 classes each term for a total of 6-8 classes per year. Students whose Home School is a Semester School (LCC, Sunset, and TPHS) must select between 5-7 classes per year. * If an unscheduled period is selected, no class or teacher will be assigned and no attendance will be taken. The only way to indicate that a student is requesting not to have a class during a specific period or term is to request an unscheduled period.
- Students are requesting classes only, not teachers or periods. No schedule changes will be made to accommodate any off-campus, extracurricular, or athletic activities. For Academy (CCA or SDA) students, enter your preferred term, but it is not guaranteed.
- Courses may be canceled due to unforeseen changes or revisions in Edgenuity offerings.
- SDUHSD Board Policy sets a limit at the beginning of each semester to add or drop a class without it reflecting on the transcript. Level changes (ex. from honors) may be requested during this period only if there is space available. The window for adding or dropping a class will be in alignment with the student's Home School add/drop deadlines.
- All 9th grade students must enroll in a Physical Education course and are required, per California Ed Code 51890, to receive the [CA Health content](#). Students who complete a SDUHSD ISPE application will be switched to ISPE only after the student is approved.
- Eligible students may apply for [Independent Study Physical Education* \(ISPE\)](#) at sduhsd.net. All Grade 10-12 students must have taken the CA fitness test before they will be approved for ISPE. **If a student is approved, the student will not be assigned to a class or teacher that period and no attendance will be taken.**
- 30 credits maximum from approved off-campus coursework can be applied to graduation requirements and coursework will **only** be added to a student's transcript if the course is pre-approved before the student enrolls in the course.
- Students will be able to view their 2026-2027 class schedules in the Aeries Portal in August. Required schedule changes will be made for students who failed a course or completed a pre-approved off-campus summer class
