Find the Online Resources drop down menu


Select the DI Strategy Toolkit

- 3. Select a Domain that you would like to read more about. Read over the contents of this domain to better understand the crosswalk between the evaluation tool (Danielson Framework) and DI. Which domain did you select and why?

Click on the DI Planning Guide icon. When you see the "DI Planning Guide: 4 Pillars & ARE" click on it to open the two page document. Hover your cursor in the black space just above the white document. Notice that a black bar across the top appears where you can download or print this document; the document online is PDF, however, it can be downloaded into a .docx document

Click the back arrow in your toolbar to navigate back to the strategy page you were exploring.


Next, select the back button to get back to the Strategy Overview.

Next, find the following back button and click on it.




Where are you now?


