#### **Cutting Instructions**

- Night of Navy CS: 8-½"x 5-½" scored at 4-¼" so that your fold is on the left side of your card base.
- Basic White CS: 5-1/4"x 4"; scrap for sentiment and fan shaped die cut.
- Fresh Freesia CS: 5-\\"x 4"
- Berry Burst CS: scrap for vase, vase handle, and frond.
- Masterfully Made DSP: 4-\(\frac{1}{4}\)"x 2-\(\frac{5}{8}\)"

### **Assembly Instructions**

 Die cut the Fresh Freesia CS using the largest Countryside Corners die and then emboss it with the Exposed Brick 3D embossing folder.

- 2. Die cut the DSP using the third from the largest Countryside Corners die and then glue it to the Fresh Freesia CS.
- 3. Die cut the vase handles and the frond out of the Berry Burst CS.
- 4. Stamp the short vase with the Berry Burst ink pad onto the Berry Burst CS and cut it out with the short vase die.
- Stamp your sentiment on the scrap of Basic White CS using Berry Burst ink and die cut it with the Stylish Shapes die.
- 6. On the 5-¼"x 4" piece of Basic White CS stamp your sentiment using Berry Burst ink and the other images using Berry Burst ink and Night of Navy ink on the lower left corner. Stamp the same images on the lower left corner of the front of the envelope and the left corner of the flap.
- 7. Glue the stamped Basic White piece to the right inside flap of your card.
- 8. Die cut one fan out of the scrap of Basic White CS.
- Starting in the center of the fan, use Berry Burst ink on the sponge dauber in a circular motion to add some color. Then follow the lines on the fan and slightly crease them to the back.
- 10. Use the sponge dauber to add more Berry Burst ink to the frond and the vase handles if desired.

- 11. Glue the handle to the back of the vase and then put two Stampin' Dimensionals on the back.
- 12. Using Night of Navy ink, stamp the branches around the outer edges of the front of the Night of Navy card base.
- 13. Trim the stem of the frond and glue it to the upper left portion of the DSP.
- 14. Put one Stampin' Dimensional in the center of the lower portion of the fan.
- 15. Place the fan in the upper section of the DSP so that it is centered from left to right.
- 16. Place the vase in the lower section of the DSP so it is centered from left to right.



- 17. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the sentiment on the right half only. Put a dab of glue on the left side.
- 18. Place the sentiment over the middle of the vase to the right making sure the dimensionals aren't on top of the vase.
- 19. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the Fresh Freesia CS and then center it on the front of your card.
- 20. Add at least three pearls to the front of your card.
